Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50l(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council. ("Siting Council") on or after February 7, 2014 by Homeland Towers, LLC ("Homeland") and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") (together the "Applicants") for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility in Ridgefield, Connecticut.

The proposed facility is located on a parcel of land owned by InSite Towers with an address of Ledges Road with access from Old Stagecoach Road in the Town of Ridgefield and identified on the Town of Ridgefield Assessor's Map as parcel D08-124 (the "Property"). The proposed facility is located in the north central portion of the Property and is proposed to extend to an overall height of 150' above grade with Town whip antennas reaching a total height of 161.5' AGL. The Property is an approximately 3.19 acre parcel which is currently

undeveloped/vacant land. The Facility is proposed to allow commercial wireless and public safety communications services in northwestern Ridgefield. The tower, antennas and ground equipment will be located within a 4,650 square foot fenced equipment compound area. Vehicle and utility access to the facility would be from the intersection of Old Stagecoach Road and Aspen Ledges Road using an existing paper street and rights-of-way that benefit the parcel.

The location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

The Application explains the need, purpose and ben-efits of the facility and also describes the environmen-tal impacts of the proposed facility. The facility will be available for co-location by other wireless carriers and it will be used for the Town's Police, Fire and Emergency Management Departments who plan to install emergency communications antennas and equipment at the site.

A balloon, representative

of the proposed height of the facility, will be flown at the proposed site on the first day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the Town of Ridgefield, or such other date specified by the Siting Council and a time to be determined by the Siting Council, but anticipated to be between the hours of 12pm and 5pm.
