Dear Chairman Stein and Executive Director Bachman:

Please accept this letter from InSite Wireless Group, LLC, in its capacity as the Manager of InSite Towers Development, LLC, holder of the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need issued by the Siting Council in Docket 451 ("Certificate"). Condition 6 of the Decision and Order dated January 14, 2015 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen (18) months from the date of the mailing of the Council's Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order. On May 13, 2016, Council granted an eighteen (18) month extension of time to January 14, 2018 to complete construction of the facility.

Although the tower is constructed and the Town's public safety equipment is installed and operational, AT&T continues at this time to make arrangements for the installation of their facility to the tower site. In keeping with Condition 7 of the Decision and Order, we respectfully request a second eighteen (18) month extension, which would extend out to July 14, 2019.
