Dear Members of the Connecticut Siting Council.

We write with regards to an application from American Tower Corporation and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 701 Lydall Street, Manchester, Connecticut.

We strongly oppose this application. Lydall Street is located in a densely populated residential area and we ask the Siting Council to consider alternative locations for this tower that would be better suited and less obtrusive.

One suggestion, directly across the street is Risley Reservoir. The land is owned by Manchester Land Trust who could be very interested in locating a tower on their property which is non-residential.

Our constituents in this section of Manchester share our concerns about the environmental impact and health risks associated with a cell tower in such close proximity to their homes.
