

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on or about December 30, 2014, by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco” or the “Applicant”). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility on an approximately 27 acre parcel at 99 East Street in Southington, Connecticut. Cellco proposes to construct a 90-foot monopole tower disguised as a pine tree in the western portion of this parcel. Access to the facility compound will extend from East Street. Cellco will also install a new 12’ x 30’ shelter located near the base of the tower to house its radio equipment and a propane-fueled back-up generator. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.

On the day of the Siting Council public hearing on this proposal, Cellco will fly a balloon at the height of the proposed tower described above.
