Dear Ms. Castro:

The State Historic Preservation Office is in receipt of the submitted proposal for the above-referenced project, submitted for review and comment pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act and in accordance with Federal Communications Commission regulations.

In the opinion of this office, the proposed undertaking, to build a 143' monopole tower with antennas and 50' by 50' fenced equipment compound within a 100' by 100' lease area, will have no adverse effect to contributing resources eligible for listing or listed on the National Register of Historic Places District, with the following conditions:

1. the tower, antennas and any associated equipment will be designed, painted to match adjacent materials, and installed to be as non-visible as possible,
2. if not in use for six consecutive months, the antennae and equipment shall be removed by the telecommunications facility owner. This removal shall occur within 90 days of the end of such six-month period.

The State Historic Preservation Office appreciates the opportunity to review and comment upon this project. These comments are provided in accordance with the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
