- 58. In New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC's (AT&T) response to interrogatory question number three, AT&T notes that some abutter notices were returned as unclaimed, and additional notice was provided by first class mail. When were the first class supplemental notices mailed?
- 59. In AT&T's response to interrogatory question number 41, AT&T notes that the proposed facility would be needed to provide capacity as well as coverage. Provide data to support the contention that the proposed facility would fill a capacity need.
- 60. Reference AT&T's response to interrogatory question number 52. Provide the main road coverage distances provided by the proposed facility at 850 MHz for the Town of Monroe, based on the proposed antenna centerline height of 151 feet.
