1. Manner in which intervenor's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings:

We intend to cross-examine witnesses, introduce and present evidence, file briefs, and conduct such discovery as permitted. There are more viable alternatives that exist including the improvement to the current substation located in Cos Cob. The proposed substation will not significantly improve reliability nor are we convinced that there is significant need for its construction. We realize that having uninterrupted, reliable and plentiful electricity is a necessity. Greenwich has been afflicted by severe and lengthy power outages, resulting from weather events in the past and this proposed \$140 M expenditure will in no way mitigate these weather related losses of power nor the time it takes to restore service following them. This is the type of reliability that is currently lacking. We do not concur with the utility that over the coming years, Greenwich will experience the same commercial growth and development, therefore calling in to question the need for this project as proposed. Lastly, there are numerous other alternatives that need to be fully explored before this utility should be permitted to place transmission lines through Bruce Park, which is a environmental sensitive, water front park. Consistent with the Town's environmental policy, it does not want any high pressure fluid filled lines through the Town and no transmission lines at all through Bruce Park.
