MOTION OF THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER COUNSEL

The Office of Consumer Counsel ("OCC") is in receipt of the 11/20/2015 Motion of Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy ("CL&P" or "Company"), and of the Siting Council's Reply of the same date granting CL&P's request to extend the due date for the last sets of interrogatory responses from 11/24/2015 to 11/30/2015.
