

M.3.2.2 Calculated Magnetic Fields from the Proposed Transmission Lines

Figure M-9 is a summary graph depicting the magnetic fields from the proposed transmission lines. This highest field would occur directly above the center of the trench and would have a value of 0.52 (0.47) mG during average annual loads. The minimum measured magnetic field from the field visits on March 3, 2015 was 0.52 mG in the vicinity of the Proposed Site.
