RE: **DOCKET NO. 461** - Eversource Energy application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV underground transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements.

#### 1. Motions.

During the public hearing held by the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) on January 12, 2016, the Council voted on the following:

**a. Town of Greenwich Request for Party Status, dated January 11, 2016**

The Town's request for party status was granted.

**b. Office of Consumer Counsel Motion for the Council to direct Eversource to follow OCC's proposed process to acquire transformer manufacturer information, dated December 21, 2015**

OCC's motion was denied.

**c. Office of Consumer Counsel Motion for Administrative Notice, dated December 23, 2015**

OCC's motion was granted

**d. Eversource Energy Motion to Exclude Cross-Examination of Applicant on Issues of Real Property Ownership, dated January 5, 2016**

Eversource's motion was **granted in part** as it relates to cross examination of real property ownership matters outside of the record and **denied in part** as it relates to cross examination of real property ownership matters that are already in the record.

#### 2. Continuation of the Evidentiary Hearing.

The Council shall conclude the evidentiary hearings for the above-referenced proceeding on **Tuesday, February 23, 2016**, in Hearing Room One, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at **11:00 a.m.**

The hearing shall commence with the appearance and cross examination of the parties and intervenors in the following order:

- a. Parker Stacy
- b. Richard Granoff



- c. **Grouped Intervenors** – Bella Nonna Restaurant & Pizzeria, Greenwich Chiropractic & Nutrition, Joel Paul Berger and Meg Glass
- d. Cecilia Morgan
- e. Town of Greenwich

Thereafter, the hearing will continue with final cross examination of the applicant by the Council, parties and intervenors in the order listed on the hearing program.

To save the time and expense of the parties, intervenors and the public, and to conclude this proceeding in a timely and efficient fashion, the Council requests that all parties and intervenors submit interrogatories to the Applicant and other parties and intervenors on or before the close of business on **February 2, 2016**. This is the final deadline for submission of additional interrogatories.

Also to save the time and expense of the parties, intervenors and the public, and to conclude this proceeding in a timely and efficient fashion, the Council requests that all parties and intervenors submit responses to interrogatories and late-filed exhibits on or before the close of business on **February 16, 2016**. This is the final deadline for submission of additional exhibits.
