Eversource requests extended work hours from 5AM to 7AM and from 6PM to 7PM on both Wednesday, October 2, 2019 and Thursday, October 3, 2019 to conduct the concrete pour for the transformer foundations at the Greenwich Substation. Normal work hours at the substation, per the approved D&M Plan, are 7 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday; therefore, this request is for an extra 3 hours each day.

All concrete foundation work will be contained on Eversource's substation property. The primary date planned for the work is October 2, with October 3 as a contingency date, if needed due to inclement weather on October 2.

The extended work hours are requested because the concrete pour for the transformer foundations requires continuous work, as well as adequate time to set the concrete. Specifically, approximately 19 concrete trucks must provide deliveries to the substation throughout the day of the pour. These extended hours are needed to allow adequate time for these truck deliveries and time for traffic delays, which are not uncommon in and around the Project area. Further, mobilization time will be required to set up the concrete pump truck on the substation site.

Eversource has consulted with representatives of the Town of Greenwich regarding this extended hour request.
