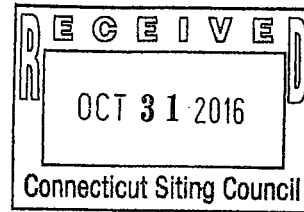

This letter is in response to your memorandum dated September 30<sup>th</sup> 2016, regarding T-Mobile’s interest in the Docket No. 463a telecommunications facility. The proposed American Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS,LLC facilities located at 351a Boston Post Road, East Lyme, Connecticut and the alternate site located at 2 Arbor Crossing, East Lyme, Connecticut would provide T-Mobile’s network with the ability to provide wireless service in the southeast Connecticut. Although, both sites are of material interest to our network T-Mobile has chosen to not intervene in the Docket No. 463a proceedings at this time.

If either site is approved T-Mobile is interested in sharing the proposed facilities. T-Mobile is currently installed at 142’ AGL on the existing pole that is set to be decommissioned and we would request a comparable height on either facility to best meet our coverage objectives.
