### I. Introduction

The application is from American Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility and associated equipment to be located at 351A Boston Post Road in the Town of East Lyme, Connecticut.

### II. Technical

The application conforms to the Council's *Application Guide for Community Antenna Television and Telecommunication Facilities* dated July 2012, includes relevant maps, descriptions of the proposed site, costs, a description of the environmental effects of the proposed construction, and health and safety information. The application meets statutory technical requirements for processing the application. This project would not require an outside consultant.

### III. Administrative Review

All service and filing requirements pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50l (b) have been fulfilled. Notice to the general public was published in *The Day* newspaper.

### IV. Procedural

The Council must schedule a hearing for the proceeding between 30 and 150 days after receipt of an application. The Council must also appoint a custodian of the docket and designate a place for the deposition of the transcript. Staff recommends designating Carriann Mulcahy as custodian of the docket, holding the public hearing in the Town of East Lyme on December 15, 2015, and depositing the transcript in the East Lyme Town Hall.
