Re: Notice to Owners of Property Abutting the Plumtree and Stony Hill Substations

Dear Neighbor:

This letter is a follow-up to communications sent to you in April 2016 regarding proposed electric system upgrades in your area. Eversource will be seeking approval from the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) to construct a new 3.4-mile 115-kilovolt (kV) overhead electric transmission line between Eversource's existing Plumtree Substation in the Town of Bethel and Brookfield Junction in the Town of Brookfield, and make related substation improvements at the Plumtree Substation in Bethel and the Stony Hill Substation in Brookfield.

The proposed upgrade, called the Southwest Connecticut Reliability Project (Project), is designed to bring the southwest Connecticut electric supply system into compliance with enhanced national and regional reliability standards.

The locations for the substation upgrades are 16 Walnut Hill Road in Bethel, Connecticut and 49 Stony Hill Road in Brookfield, Connecticut. Since one of the locations for the proposed substation upgrades abuts your property, we are committed to keep you informed.

This letter is to provide notice of Eversource's intent to apply to the Council on or about June 30, 2016 for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for this Project. After reviewing the Application for completeness, the Council will conduct a local public hearing (date and location to be set by the Council). If the Project is approved by the Council, we anticipate starting construction in the first quarter of 2018, with completion by the end of 2018. This schedule is approximate and subject to change. Please note this work will not interrupt electric service to homes or businesses.
