RE: **DOCKET NO. 468** - The Connecticut Light & Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Southwest Connecticut Reliability Project that traverses the municipalities of Bethel, Danbury, and Brookfield, which consists of (a) construction, maintenance and operation of a new 115-kV overhead electric transmission line entirely within existing Eversource right-of-way and associated facilities extending approximately 3.4 miles between Eversource's existing Plumtree Substation in the Town of Bethel to its existing Brookfield Junction in the Town of Brookfield; (b) reconfiguration of two existing 115-kV double-circuit electric transmission lines at Eversource's existing Stony Hill Substation in the Town of Brookfield; and (c) related substation modifications.

Dear Ms. Bellion:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of April 4, 2018, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced project to allow work at the Stony Hill Substation in Brookfield on Sunday, April 8, 2018 in order to remove a structure and conductors and install new conductors on existing transmission structures. All work will be performed from 7 AM to 7 PM. These additional work hours are necessary to keep the project on schedule as work crew time was lost due to crew reassignment associated with recent storm events.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of April 4, 2018. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on July 21, 2017. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

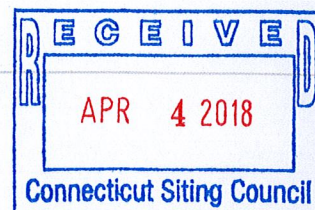

Eversource is requesting approval of Sunday work hours (7AM to 7PM) on April 8<sup>th</sup> from Council staff to remove and install conductors on existing transmission structures and to remove an existing 3-pole wood pole structure on Eversource property at the Stony Hill Substation. The reason for the request is the need to do this work during a planned outage and to recover lost time due to the crews being reassigned to storm restoration efforts the past few weeks.
