
I, Timothy Eves, being duly sworn, deposes and states that:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and I understand the obligations of a statement under oath.
2. I am the Vice President of NTE Connecticut, LLC ("NTE"), responsible for all aspects of planning, development, permitting and community relations related to the Killingly Energy Center ("KEC") project.
3. NTE has proposed the establishment of the KEC, a 650 MW electric power generating facility at 180 and 189 Lake Road in Killingly, Connecticut (collectively, the "Site").
4. Under my direction, NTE was responsible for the posting two "Public Notice Signs" at the Site.
5. In accordance with Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") guidelines, the public notice signs were posted on March 14, 2019.
