to date are available at the Council's office or on our website under pending proceedings.

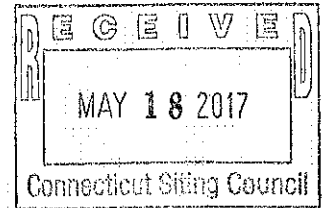
