Dear Ms. Gustafson:

The State Historic Preservation Office is in receipt of the proposal for the above-referenced project, submitted for review and comment pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act and in accordance with Federal Communications Commission regulations.

It is the opinion of this office that the proposed undertaking, which includes the construction of a new 90' monopole within a 2500 sq.ft. fenced compound at the subject property, will have no adverse effect to sites eligible for listing as contributing resources to a potential National Register of Historic Places District, with the following conditions:

1. The tower, antennas and the associated equipment will be designed and installed to be as non-visible as possible,
2. if not in use for six consecutive months, the enclosures, antennas and equipment shall be removed by the telecommunications facility owner. This removal shall occur within 90 days of the end of such six-month period.

The State Historic Preservation Office appreciates the opportunity to review and comment upon this project. These comments are provided in accordance with the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
