



## CONNECTICUT

### Appeal Denied In 1999 Murder Of Child, 8

HARTFORD — A Connecticut appeals court has upheld the murder conviction of a Bridgeport man in the fatal shooting of an 8-year-old boy who was scheduled to testify in another murder case.

Adrim Peeler had argued that his attorneys failed to call a key witness who would have contradicted testimony from a woman who told jurors she saw him shoot B.J. Brown and Brown's mother, Karen Clarke, to death inside their home in January 1999.

The boy was to be a witness in a murder case against Peeler's brother, Russell. The Appellate Court ruled Monday that lawyers failed to show the testimony from the man, a crack cocaine user, would have been helpful. It also rejected Peeler's claim that telephone records from the day of the slaying would have helped his defense. —Associated Press

### Suspect In Fatal Shooting Captured

HARTFORD — A second man has been arrested in connection with the July 26 fatal shooting of Everett Scott on Kenyon Court, police said.

Keith "Boosie" Hurst, 21, of Pliny Street, was arrested Monday after he

tried to flee a Westfield apartment that was surrounded by city officers and federal marshals, police said. He was charged with first-degree murder, conspiracy to commit robbery and conspiracy to commit felony murder, police said. He also was charged with criminal possession of a firearm and criminal use of a firearm.

He was arraigned Monday in Superior Court, where his bail was set at \$1 million. His next court date was scheduled for Nov. 16.

Police arrested a man who is suspected of being a co-conspirator, Phillip "Whitney" Williams, 27, on Thursday on murder and other charges. Williams was held on \$2.5 million bail.

Everett Scott, 47, was the victim of the city's 19th homicide this year. He was found in a red minivan with a gunshot wound to the chest. Officers found drugs in his vest pocket, according to the warrant.

A witness told police that Scott had planned to sell a kilogram of cocaine to another man, the warrant said.

The witness saw Scott pull out Kenyon Court that day and then saw a white car pull in front of him, blocking his view, the warrant said. Not long after, two men got out of the car and approached Scott, the witness said, and

he saw an argument start and Scott was shot.

Investigators say the two men were Williams and Hurst. They found Hurst's palm print on the outside of a side window of the red minivan, police said.

Police said Hartford officers and the U.S. Marshal Service Violent Fugitive Task Force found Hurst at an apartment on Folly Brook Boulevard about 7 a.m. Monday. They set up a perimeter, and while some officers went to the front, Hurst ran out the back, where more officers were waiting to take him into custody, police said. —Christine Dempsey, David Owens

The woman, Casey Clark, 24, of Edgewood Street, Hartford, was charged with conspiracy to commit first-degree robbery, first-degree robbery, conspiracy to commit second-degree larceny and second-degree larceny, police said. Her bail was set at \$100,000.

The male robbers were described as about 20 years old and wearing black clothing. One had short hair and a black revolver, the other wore his hair in braids, police said.

Officer Theresa Vey bought the victim new pants and shoes, police said. —Christine Dempsey

### Woman Freed From Car After Rollover

COLUMBIA — Roll-overs pulled a Portland woman from her car after it had crashed and rolled over on Route 66 Sunday morning, state police said.

Susan Shea was driving east shortly before 10:30 a.m. when the car went off the east side of the road, striking a guard rail anchor, they said. The car flipped onto an embankment and came to a rest in heavy brush, police said.

Bysanders pulled Shea, 53, out of the car and she was airlifted to Hartford Hospital, where she was in critical condition as of Monday afternoon. —Christine Dempsey

### Robbery Victim Loses Credit Cards, Pants

HARTFORD — A man who tried to buy marijuana from a woman became the victim of a robbery at gunpoint during which his credit cards and pants were stolen, police said Monday.

The man also lost his cellphone, identification, bus tickets and shoes in the holdup, which happened shortly before 9:30 p.m. in a car outside 19 Warren St., they said.

According to police, two men, one with a gun, approached the vehicle during the supposed drug deal and ordered the victim out of the car, then got into the vehicle and drove off, they said.

Members of the department's Shooting Task Force responded and found the woman behind 148 Wooster St.

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## Mobil Gas Station On Elm Street To Be Renovated

ENFIELD — The planning and zoning commission Thursday night approved plans for a Mobil gas station on Elm Street to renovate and expand their building to include a convenience store and drive-thru

Dunkin' Donuts. The existing Mobil gas station at 100 Elm St. is 925 square feet and sits on 0.85 acres in front of Enfield Square Mall.

The planning and zoning commission approved plans for Mobil to expand the store to 3,850 square feet and include a convenience store and a drive-thru Dunkin'

Donuts. Assistant town planner Shawn Raigrich said Mobil's underground storage tanks are reaching the end of their life expectancy, and state Department of Energy and Environmental Protection standards dictate that they should be replaced soon.

While making necessary changes to meet

DEEP's standards, the owners wanted to make upgrades to their store. The commission approved the request with a 6-0 vote.

Raigrich said Friday that the gas station would next apply for building permits before moving forward with construction.

Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”) will host a Public Information Meeting on Monday, November 30, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. in the Cromwell Town Hall, Town Council Meeting Room 224, 41 West Street in Cromwell, CT to discuss a proposal by Cellco to construct a wireless telecommunications facility at 667 Main Street in Cromwell.

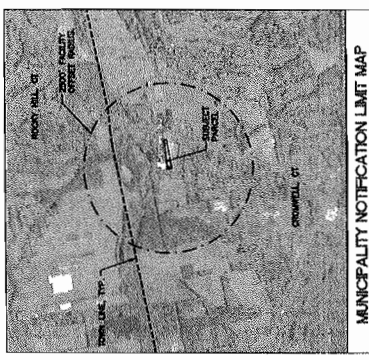

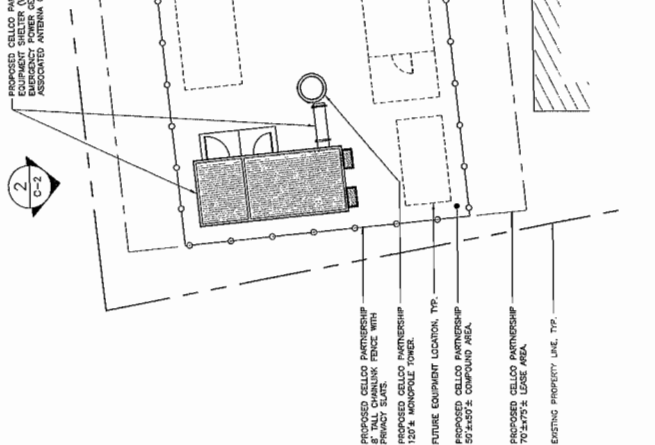

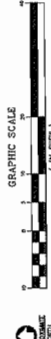
**3 ANTENNA MOUNTING CONFIGURATION**

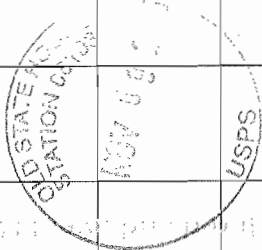

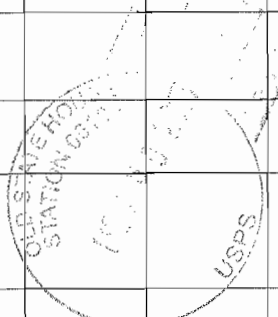

Dear Mayor Faienza and Chief Salvatore:

As you may recall, back on October 30, 2015, I sat down with the two of you to discuss plans by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”), to construct a wireless telecommunications facility on property owned by Cromwell Concrete Products Inc. (“CCP”) at 667 Main Street in Cromwell (“Property”). In order to improve wireless service in the area, Cellco would construct a 120-foot monopole tower and install radio equipment and a back-up generator within a 50’ x 50’ fenced compound in the northwest corner of the Property.

Following our meeting and at your request, Cellco hosted a Public Information Meeting at Cromwell Town Hall on November 30, 2015. Notice of that meeting was sent to all adjoining property owners and was published in a local newspaper. During the Public Information Meeting several residents asked Cellco to contact the owner of the property at 675 Main Street (the Gardner property) and consider this parcel as an alternative to the CCP site. Cellco agreed to reach out to Mr. Gardner and pursue a tower lease on his property at 675 Main Street as an alternative for consideration by the Siting Council. After two years and considerable effort, Cellco and Mr. Gardner have now formally terminated lease negotiations. That said, Cellco still has a need for a new facility in this area and will be seeking Siting Council approval for a new tower site on the CCP parcel.



This firm represents Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”) in its proposal to construct a new wireless telecommunications facility on property at 667 Main Street in Cromwell (the “Property”). The Property is owned and operated by Cromwell Concrete Products, Inc. (“CCP”). The proposed telecommunications facility will consist of a 120-foot monopole tower located in the northwest corner of the Property. The tower, Cellco’s radio equipment platform and a back-up generator would be located within a 50’ x 50’ fenced facility compound. A copy of the project site plans are attached for your review.

On November 30, 2015, Cellco hosted a public information meeting at Cromwell Town Hall regarding the proposed telecommunications facility, which you may have attended. At that meeting several attendees asked Cellco to consider locating the tower to the north of the Property, on a parcel owned by Gardners Nurseries, Inc. (“Gardner”) at 675 Main Street. Shortly after the November 30, 2015 public meeting, Cellco contacted Gardner in an effort to secure a ground lease for a tower site on this parcel. After two years of negotiations, Cellco and Gardner could not reach an agreement on a tower lease. Lease negotiations were formally terminated on November 28, 2017.

Cellco's need for improved wireless service in the northern portions of Cromwell remains a priority, however. As such, Cellco intends to move forward with its application to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for a new wireless telecommunications facility at the Property as described above. 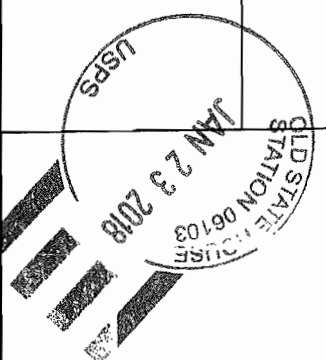
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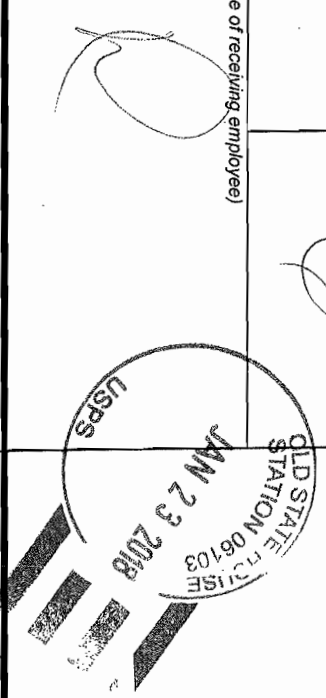
