Dear Ms. Bachman,

I am writing to express T-Mobile's support of Docket #485, a proposed replacement for the recently dismantled water tower owned by Connecticut Water, LLC.

T-Mobile has continuously maintained a wireless facility at 1542 Boston Post Road in Westbrook for nearly 20 years. The wireless facility on the water tank provided coverage to a large section of Westbrook as well as to mobile traffic on Route 1 traveling through the area.

CT Water sent notice of their intent to terminate the lease for the water tank due to the fact that it had deteriorated beyond the point of repair. Since the site is a critical part of our cellular network, we cannot afford any loss of coverage.

T-Mobile's wireless site was relocated to the temporary tower that is currently located on the CT Water property. A permanent long-term tower site solution in this part of Westbrook is a critical part of T- Mobile's network services to residents and visitors to Westbrook.

Attached is a coverage plot showing the coverage T-Mobile anticipates providing from a permanent tower site which replicates the coverage T-Mobile provided prior to demolition of the water tank. This is a wide area coverage site and an important part of T-Mobile's existing network services.

Due to the maturity of the wireless network in this area, there is very little latitude for the location of the permanent replacement site.


