Quality of Life Result: Connecticut children grow up stable, safe, healthy, and ready to lead successful lives.





Percent of clients who met treatment goals





Percent of discharged cases demonstrating a 5-point increase in Ohio Scales-Level of Functioning Worker and Parent Scales


