WITNESS STATEMENT OF Robert M. Calzone

I, Robert M. Calzone, date of birth 1957,
of 335 Connecticut Ave, town /city of Bridgeport,

make the following statement, without fear, threat, or promise. I have been advised that any statement(s) made herein which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his/her official function, is a crime under C.G.S. section 53a-157.

I responded to a report of multiple victims of PD involved shots fired from AMR HQ at above address. It was approx 1905 hours. My dispatcher advised me that an ambulance was responding "from Fairfield." Due to my proximity to the incident scene, I arrived @ 1909. As I arrived, I noticed victim lying prone on roadway perpendicular to curb with a single officer standing over him. The officer advised that a 2nd victim was on the "other side of the car." Based on my 30+ years of experien in EMS, from EMT to Advanced EMT to Paramedic, and multiple encounters with shooting victims, I visually determined that victim 1 was deceased. This conclusion was made due to the ashen gray skin indicating severe blood loss, estimated 2 liters of blood pooled at the curb, no pulse, no respirations, pupils fixed and dilated. Presumption of death @ 1912 hours as noted in CAD notes, page 2, as SIGNAL 12. I then moved to victim #2 as I was still the only medical responder on scene. As I started to identify #2 wounds, the ambulance arrived and I turned care of patient #2 over to that crew. I treated this incident as an MCI, as I knew there were multiple victims and my assistance was approx. 4-5 minutes out.

I arrived on scene prior to PD securing the scene perimeter. My vehicle ended up inside the secured scene, my departure then required PD to move crime scene tape to enable my vehicle to exit. I cleared from incident @ 1722 and returned to station.
