I AM SPEAKING TO Detective John Kimball in Norwalk today regarding  
an event I witnessed on 05-09-2017 at about 5:00 PM in Bridgeport near  
the Volanos (1000 Park Ave.). At that time I was driving W/B  
on Fairfield Avenue adjacent to the Volanos. I am a

had at that time I was roaming waiting for a notification. I  
drive a 2013 Hyundai Sonata (CT Reg. \_\_\_\_\_) which is registered to  
me. I was in the right lane of two travel lanes approaching the  
intersection with Park Ave. I stopped in traffic in the right lane. I  
saw a blue Subaru Forester stop in the S/E exit driveway <sup>of Volanos</sup> onto Fairfield  
Ave. A marked Bridgeport Police cruiser pulled right up behind the  
Subaru. Both doors of the police car open and the officer who emerged  
from the passenger side immediately ran around the open door and  
towards the P/S of the Subaru. The officer disappeared behind the  
Subaru, and was alongside the P/S of the Subaru at some point when  
the Subaru began to move forward onto Fairfield Ave. The Subaru  
lurched forward a few inches, stopped for a matter of seconds, then  
lurched forward again out into Fairfield Ave. the wrong way (W/B).  
I could not tell exactly what was going on but I know other  
vehicles were moving around. So I pulled forward a few feet  
and ended up partially on the right shoulder with the front of

my ear angled slightly to the right. I remained in this position for the remainder of the event. I was about 60 feet away from the Subaru. The Subaru was wedged in between 2 ongoing vehicles and could not move. I believe that the passenger in the police car, the one who was alongside the Subaru when it drove into Fairfield Avenue, ended up on the PLS of the Subaru. The other officer was standing at the driver's door of the Subaru. Both officers have their guns out and are pointing them towards the Subaru. The officer at the PLS of the Subaru was yelling, "Get out of the fucking car or I'm gonna fucking shoot you!" My attention was on the passenger side officer when it came to talking. The driver's side officer opened the driver's door. The door remained open approximately 15 seconds. During this time I continued to hear the PLS officer yelling for the occupants to get out of the car. During this period neither of the occupants exited the Subaru. Both officers still have their guns up. I could not see the hands of either vehicle occupants so they were not holding their hands up. I am looking back and forth at both officers. I don't remember if the vehicle was moving or not. I did not see the first shot - I heard it. I was probably looking at a black SUV which was in the left lane alongside me who was backing up out of the area. That SUV ended up grazing the left rear corner of my Hyundai. After hearing the first shot, I looked back over at the Subaru and I saw the DS officer standing next to the

SUBARU. THE DRIVER'S DOOR REMAINED OPEN AND I REMEMBER BEING ABLE TO SEE THE OFFICER WAS PARTIALLY BEHIND THE DRIVER'S DOOR. I DON'T REMEMBER NOTICING IF THE CAR WAS MOVING OR STATIONARY. I HEARD AND SAW THE DISCHARGED FIRE ARMS (4) WERE SHOT INTO THE SUBARU WITHIN APPROXIMATELY TWO (2) FEET. THE PIS OFFICER DID NOT SHOOT. I REMEMBER HEARING ONE OF THE PEOPLE IN THE SUBARU SAY SOMETHING LIKE, "YOU SHOT ME, DUDE, REALLY?" I HEARD THE DRIVER SAY "I THINK YOU GOT MY HEART." ONE OF THE OFFICERS CALLED ON HIS RADIO FOR THE PARAMEDICS RIGHT AFTER THE SHOTS. I DON'T REMEMBER HOW THEY GOT THE DRIVER OUT BUT I REMEMBER SEEING HIM LYING ON THE GROUND FACE DOWN IN HANDCUFFS. THE DRIVER WAS STILL. AT THIS POINT I BEGAN LOOKING AROUND TO SEE HOW TO GET OUT OF THERE. I DIDN'T WITNESS ANYTHING ELSE REGARDING THE DRIVER OR THE PASSENGER. EVENTUALLY A BRIDGEPORT POLICE OFFICER LET ME LEAVE THE SCENE. X X
