make the following statement, without fear, threat, or promise. I have been advised that any statement(s) made herein which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his/her official function, is a crime under C.G.S. section 53a-157.

On Wednesday on May 10th, 2017 at approximately 1100 hrs I was dropped off at the store (corner just/Fairfield one) by a friend. At which time, I observed two Puerto Rican women standing by a small vigil with candles at the base of a light pole on Fairfield one by Walgreens, one of the women was crying and had a mop in her hand using ^{liquid} to clean up blood related to an incident the day before. I offered to mop the blood up as she was upset. as I mopped a "Fragment" or "Bullet Fragment" flung a little bit from the mop head. I immediately stopped and called the BPT police via 9-1-1 to report what I found. I told the police where I was and shortly thereafter they showed up. I then placed a piece of plastic over the "fragment" with two stones to keep it from moving. No one touched it (the fragment). I then remained in the area if more information was needed.
