Action Taken: On 05/09/17, pursuant to an active investigation assisting the Bridgeport Police Department, I was assigned by Sgt. K. Ventresca #256 to interview a witness to the incident. This witness was waiting to be spoken with inside Walgreens. Det. Pearston and I spoke with and took a voluntary, written statement from which relayed the following information:

"On 5/9/17 around 4:20pm, my girlfriend, , and I were driving East on Fairfield Ave. I was driving and stopped at the traffic light. There was one car behind me, a female driver, began blowing her horn for me to go after I heard the first gunshot. The traffic light was still red on our end so I wasn't going. After I heard the gunshot, I started looking in my mirrors. I saw the SUV sandwiched between 3 police cars. I saw the SUV driving back and forth among all the police cars; he was ramming them because I saw all the cars moving. From where I was, I could only see one officer and I could tell he was firing into the vehicle because I saw him moving around it. As soon as the traffic light changed, everyone started panicking and I drove straight. asked if the cops killed him so we drove around the block and thats when a cop asked if I saw anything and then asked if we could stick around. I want to add, that I heard sirens right before we came to the traffic light, which was still green, and thats
