**MEMORANDUM OF DECISION**

On April 5, 2018, after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on the charge of failure to file or pay unemployment contributions, in violation of Section 30-55a of the Connecticut General Statutes. Despite proper notice, the Respondent did not appear.


John Ciotto of the Connecticut Labor Department testified at the hearing. He stated Liquor Connection has failed to pay unemployment insurance and owes \$4,597.30 as of the date of this hearing. He stated they have also visited the store on two occasions to no avail.

Attorney Anderson stated based upon the circumstance of this case it is recommended the liquor permit be suspended in accordance with C.G.S. Sec. 30-55a.




