1. 8:30 AM Call to order; Mr. Vallieres called the meeting to order at 8:31 AM.

2. Review Minutes of Previous Meetings:

A. Review Minutes of Meeting of *February 10, 2012*; Mr. Vallieres noted Agenda Item 2(A) for today's meeting shall be corrected to read "...minutes of February 10, 2012." The Board voted, unanimously, to approve the minutes as presented today. (Soter/Halloran)

3. Report from Trade Practice Division;

(A) Mr. Richard Maloney addressed the Board regarding his Division Status. He noted that he presently has two occupational inspectors and one secretary. The Department receives approximately 400 cases per year out of which approximately one hundred are electrical complaints. Mr. Maloney described the general nature of most of this Board's complaints. It was noted that his Department is very shorthanded. He also noted that his Department is trying to focus on the more important safety issues for the consumer which involves more field inspections.

Mr. Soter asked Mr. Maloney what happens to contractors that are sent from this Board to Trade Practices with sworn affidavits that state that the applicants before the Board have worked for them. In response, the Department has to interview each contractor to determine where the applicants did in fact work. It is found often that many applicants are less than truthful in telling who they worked for in the past.

Mr. Halloran stated that in the future this Board will try to send the aggregis complaints in an effort to help the Department close these cases. The Board wants to do their part to assist the Department in protecting the consumer. The Board also wants the Department to have their investigators out in the field as much as possible. Mr. Halloran thanked Mr. Maloney for providing the Board with copies of the closed cases they asked for previously and that the paperwork clearly demonstrates the diligent effort the Department makes in settling these matters which pleases him and the test of the Board.

In conclusion, Mr. Maloney asked the Board that he would like them to consider an Occupational Contract which would help the Department in determining the scope of work the consumer has paid for and aid them in resolving complaints. The form of contract currently being used for home improvement was suggested as a base to develop the Occupational Contract. The Board was very pleased with their discussion with Mr. Maloney and thanked him for coming to the Board meeting today

Mr. Vallieres stated that spoke with Plumbing Board Chairman and confirmed, as this Board's minutes show, that Plumbing Inspectors are not exempt from having to comply with continuing education to maintain their license issued by the Department of Consumer Protection.

Mr. Vallieres responded on behalf of this Board to an e-mail he received from Mr. Robert Nuzzi on February 21, 2012 requesting a response from the Board as to the status of the exemption for CEU classes for electrical inspectors so that he can forward the information to his managers. Mr. Vallieres stated that the Board discussed this matter on March 9, 2012 and decided that they would not grant such exemption for electrical inspectors and that they would be required to take the prescribed CEU class for renewal of their electrical license.

The Board also agreed that should Mr. Nuzzi's Department want to submit a curriculum as per this Board's requirements when CEU curriculums are submitted for review, the Board would certainly entertain and review that submittal. Mr. Vallieres referred Mr. Nuzzi to the Department of Consumer Protection's website for curriculum outlines and application dates.

21. New Business:

- (A) Mr. Vallieres addressed a letter received by the Board at today's meeting from Mr. Vincent J. Pietrorazio dated February 29, 2012. The letter concerns Mr. Pietrorazio's request for the Board to consider a waiver of the two (2) year Journeyperson tenure as a prerequisite for candidacy for the E-1 license. Mr. Vallieres noted that this information came in late to the Board. Mr. Vallieres stated that this individual shall be asked to come before the Board at their next regular meeting scheduled for April 13, 2012.
