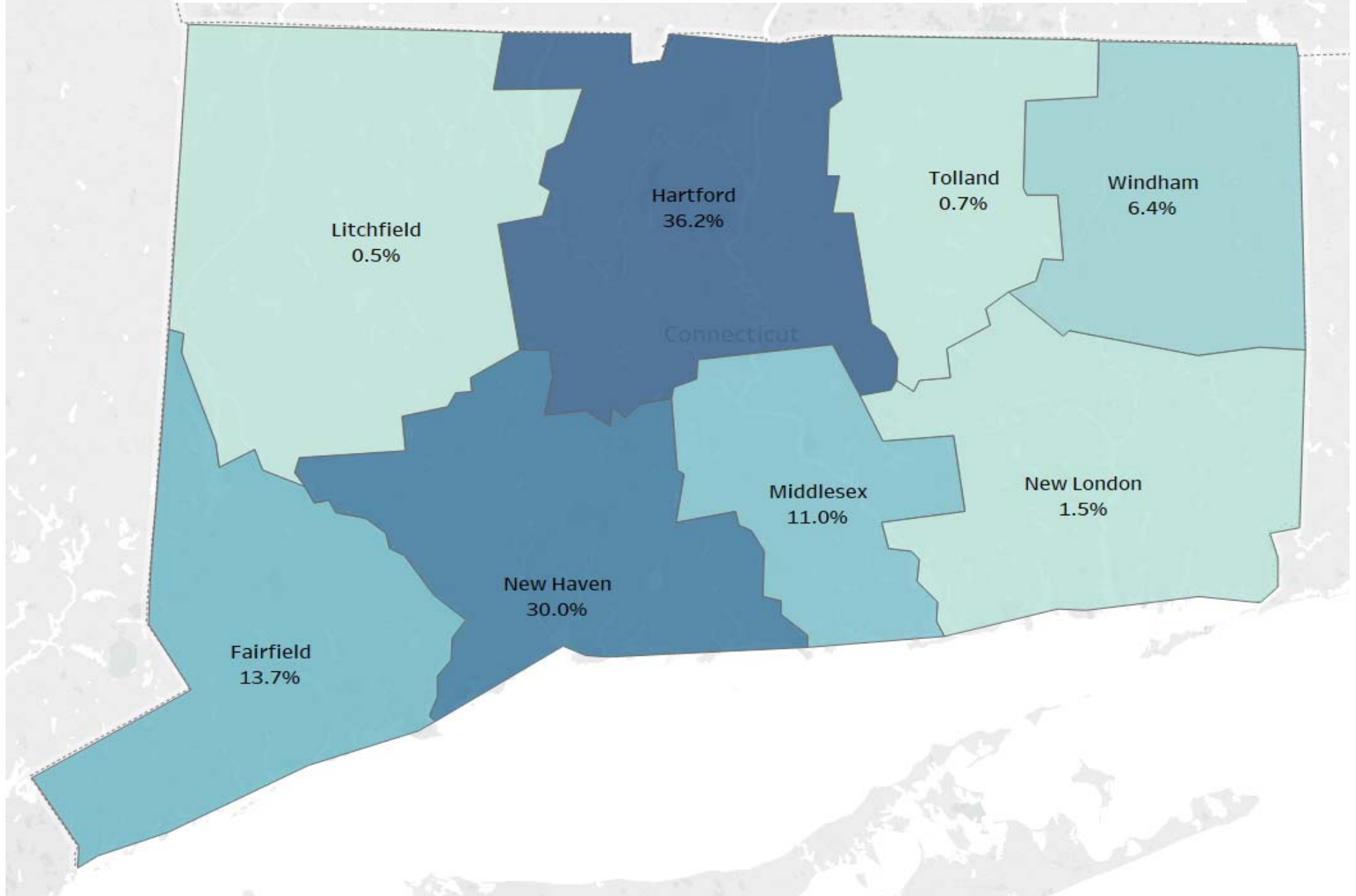

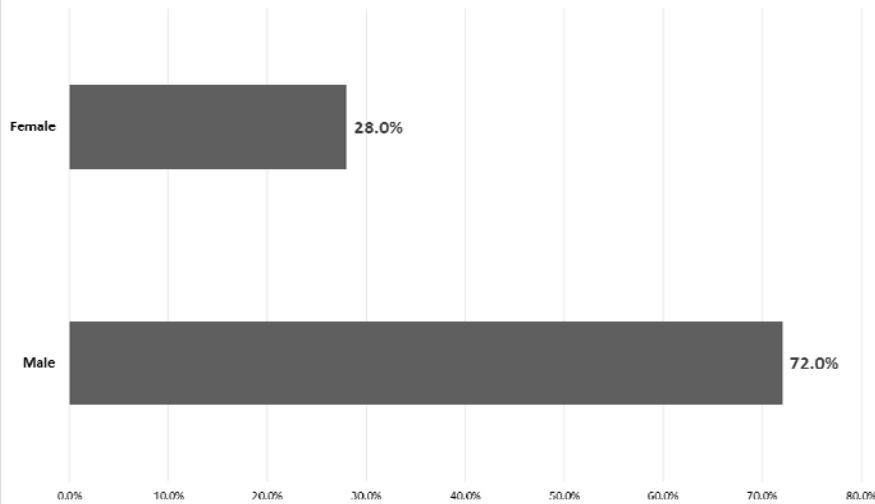
- **From January 1 – June 30, 2018**
  - *1,615 unduplicated clients; 50% (806) were new clients*
  - *3,107 total visits*
  - *Averaging 518 client visits per month (Range: 414 – 635)*
  - *Averaging 134 New clients per month (Range: 74 – 198)*
  
- **94.6% (2,939) of SSP visits by client for personal harm reduction services**
  - *5.4% (168) of SSP visits for personal harm reduction services and secondary distribution*
  
- **Syringes**
  - *Distributed: 249,005*
  - *Collected: 113,345*
  
- **187 SSP clients received overdose (OD) prevention training services**
  - *84 (45%) OD kits (naloxone) were distributed to newly trained SSP clients*
  - *103 (55%) OD kits (naloxone) were re-supply to SSP clients previously trained*

(N =1,615)**

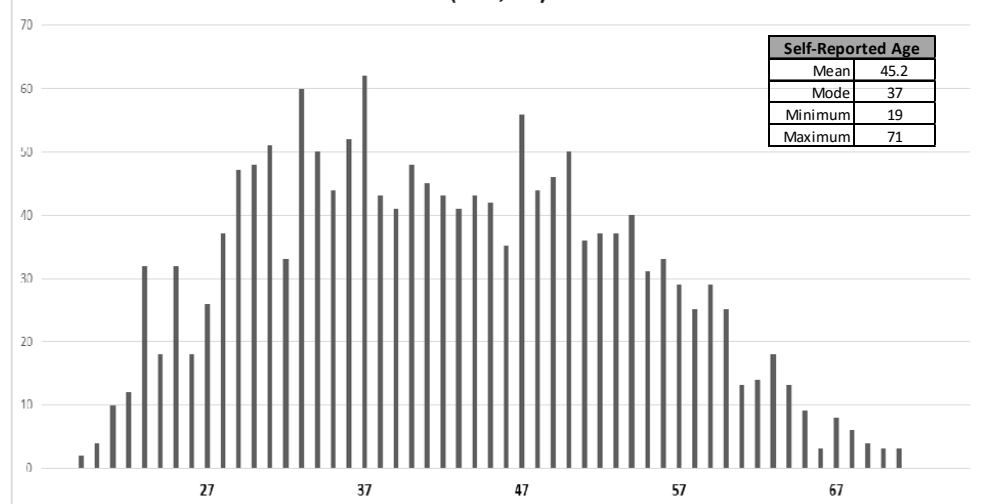

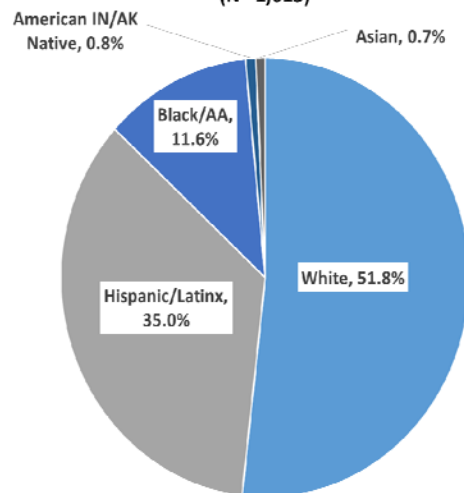
**Chart 1. SSP Clients by Self-Reported Gender, January - June, 2018

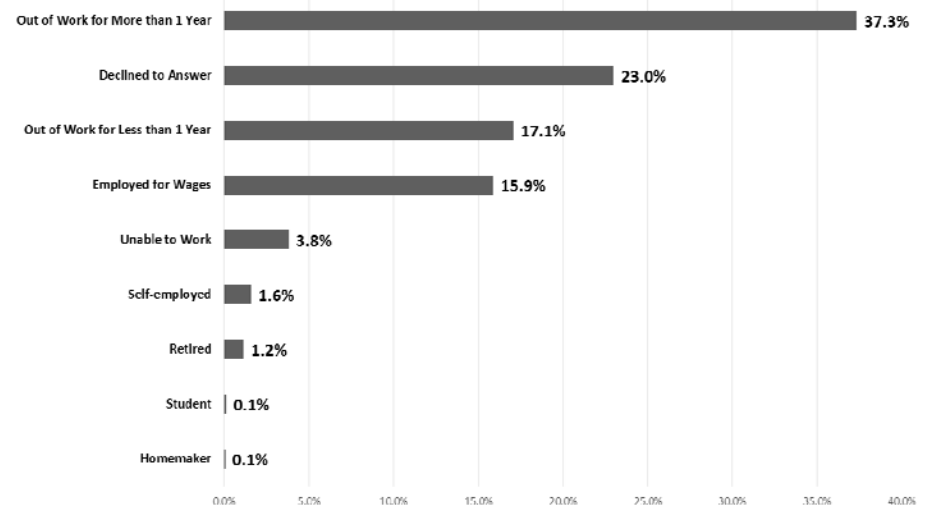
**Chart 2. SSP Clients Age Distribution, January - June, 2018  
(N =1,615)**



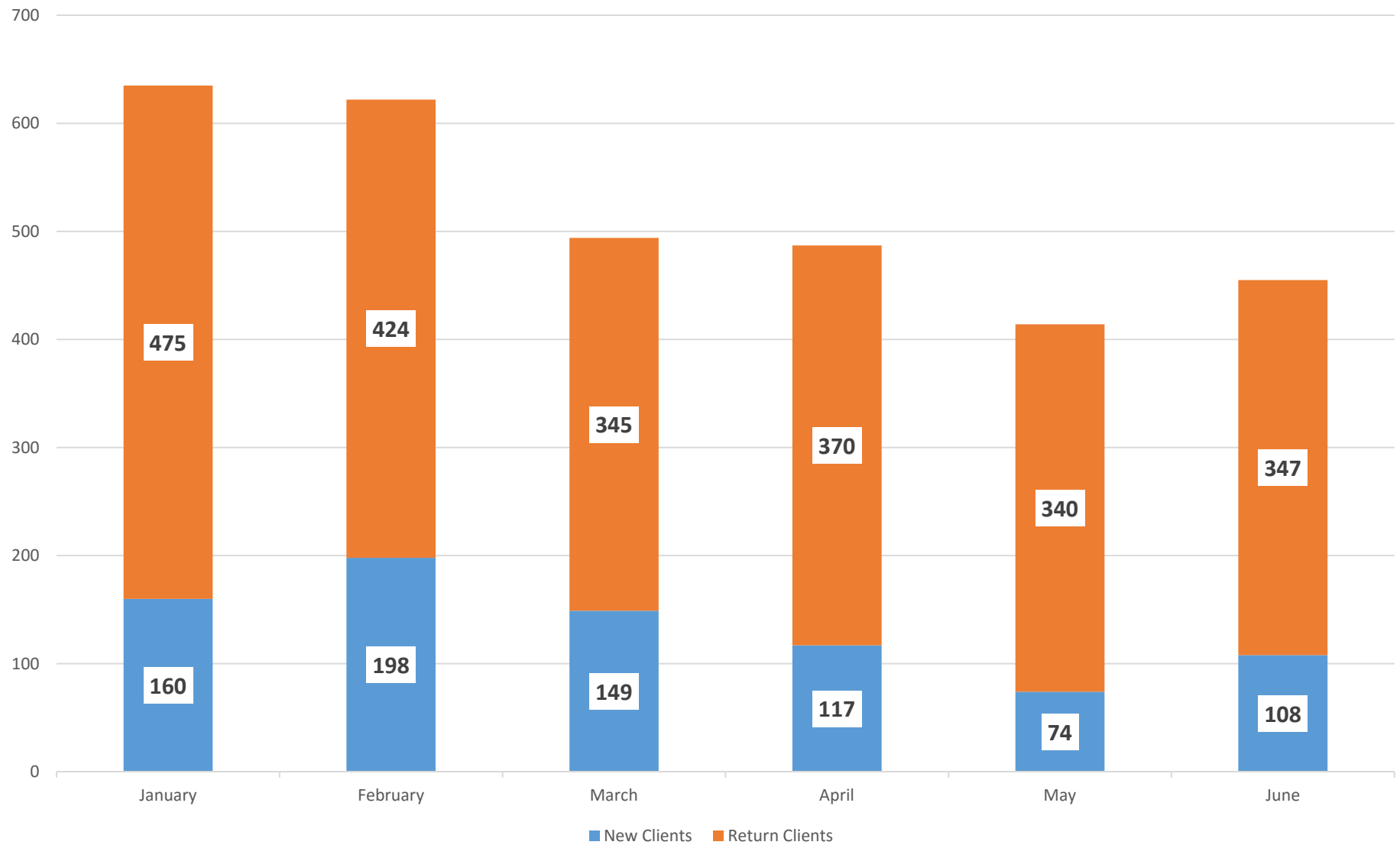
**Chart 3. SSP Clients by Self-Reported Race/Ethnicity, January - June, 2018

(N =1,615)**



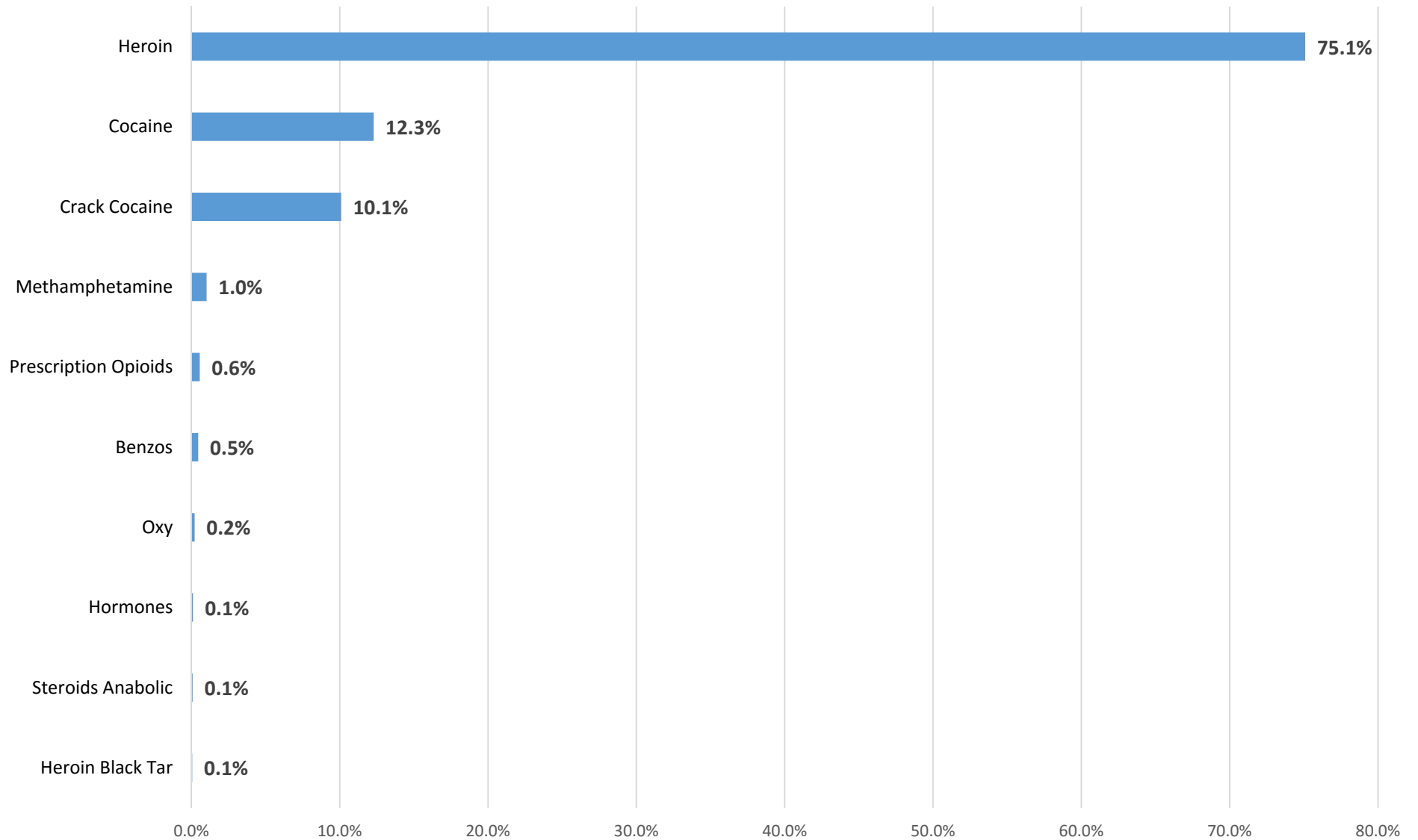
**Figure 2. Number of New and Return Clients Per Month, January-June, 2018

### Figure 3. Number of Syringes Collected and Distributed by Month, January-June, 2018

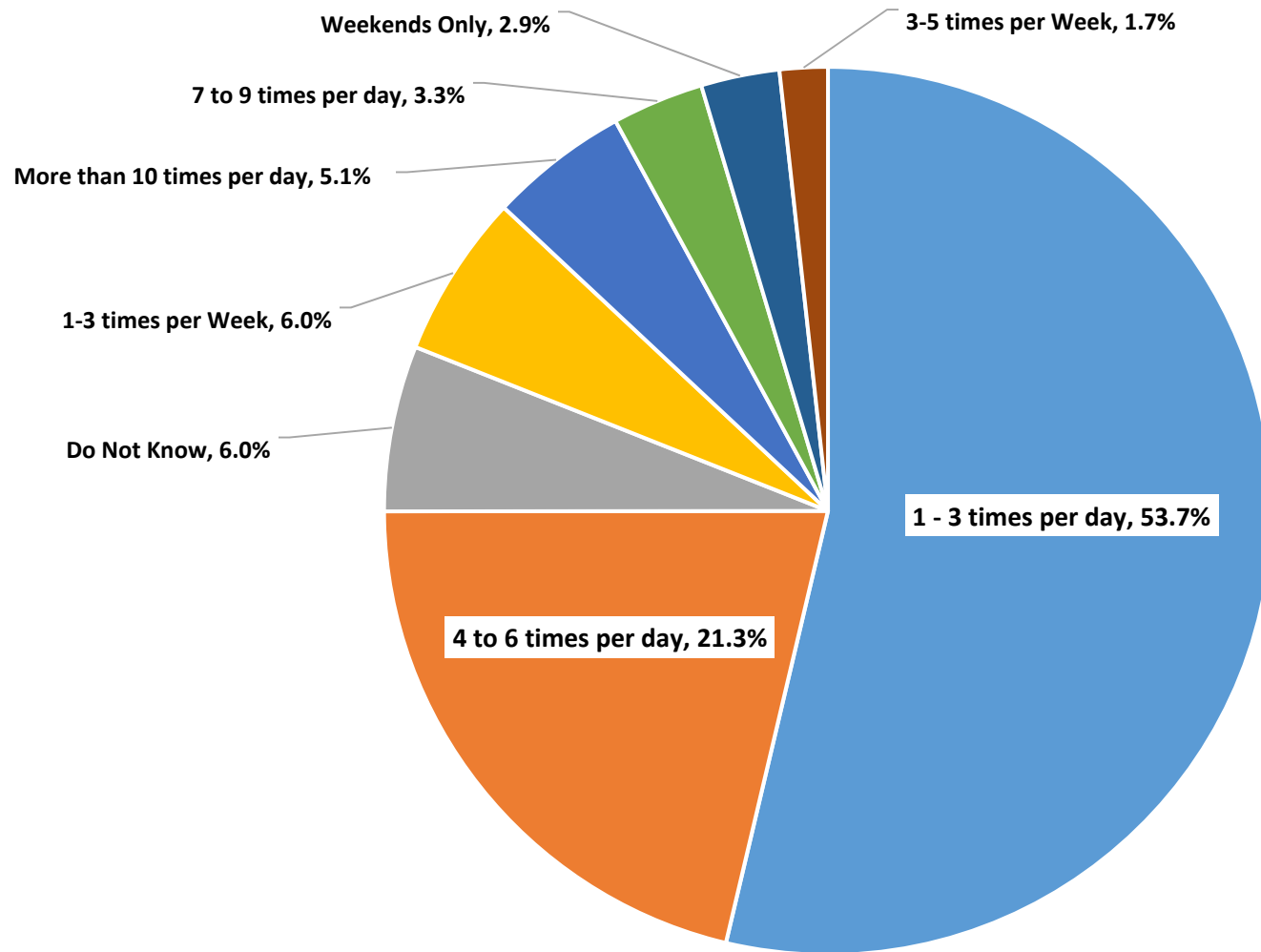


**Figure 4. Primary Substance Used as Self-Reported by SSP Clients, January - June, 2018  
(N =1,615)**

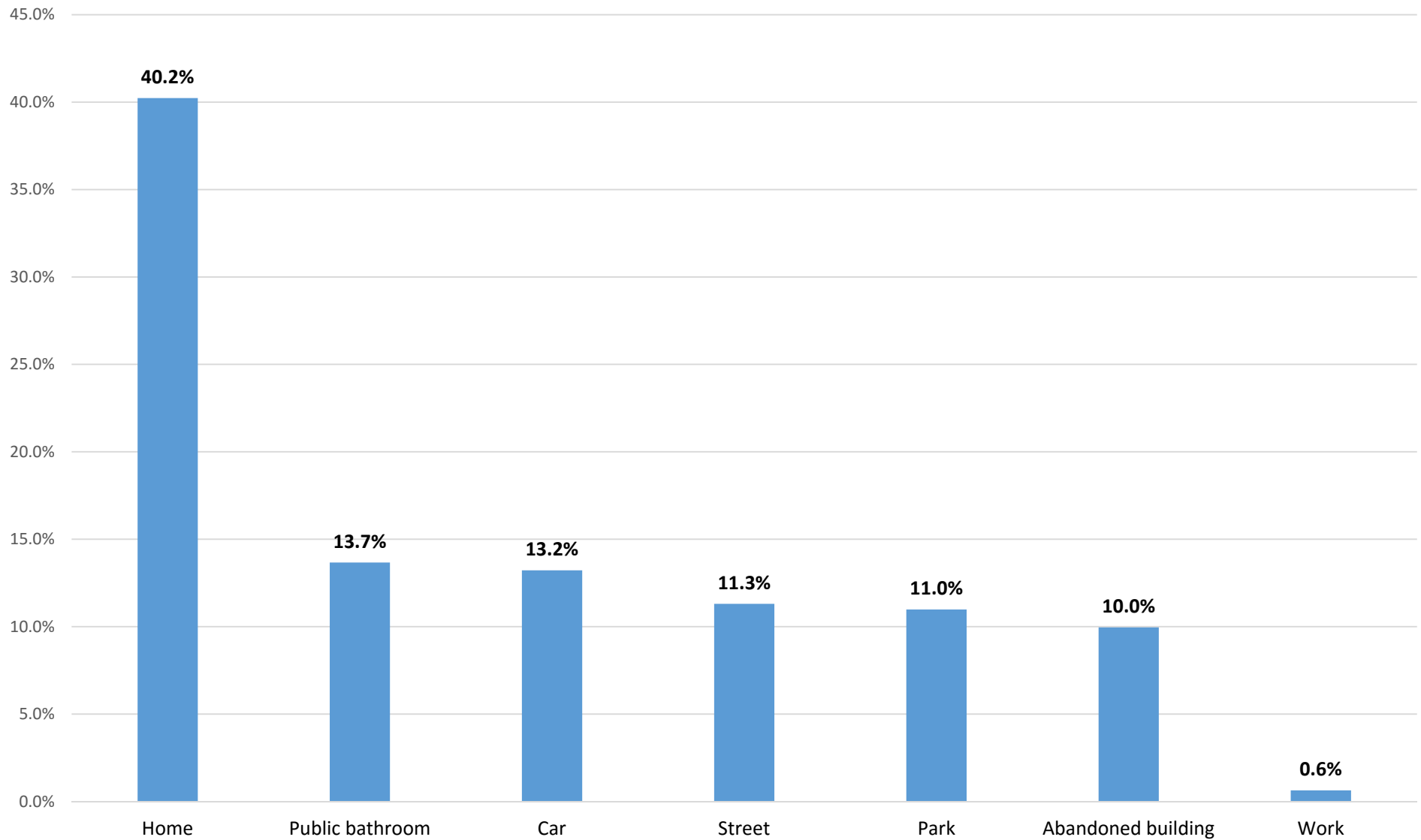




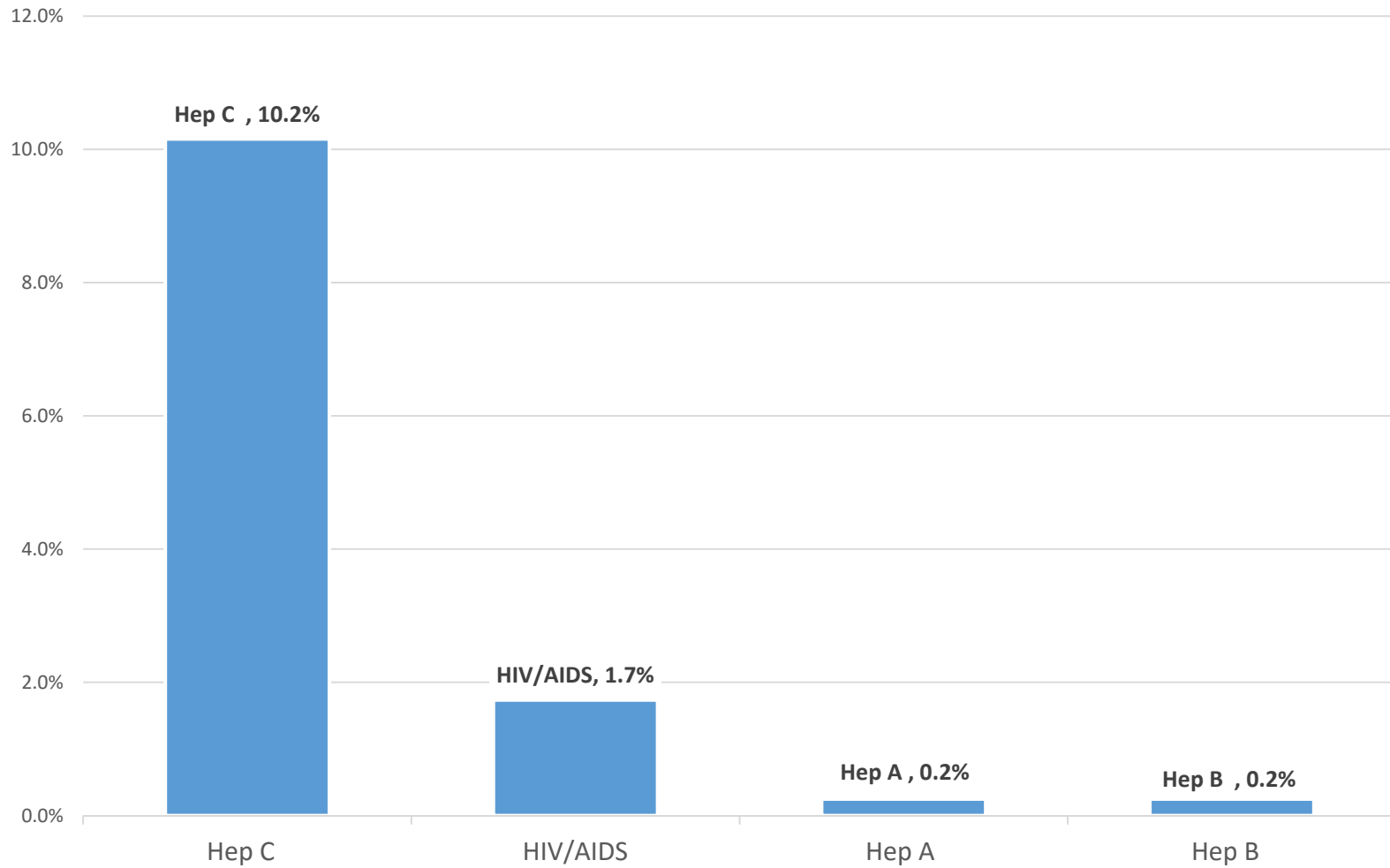
**Figure 5. Self-reported Injection Frequency by SSP Clients, January-June, 2018  
(N = 1,615)**



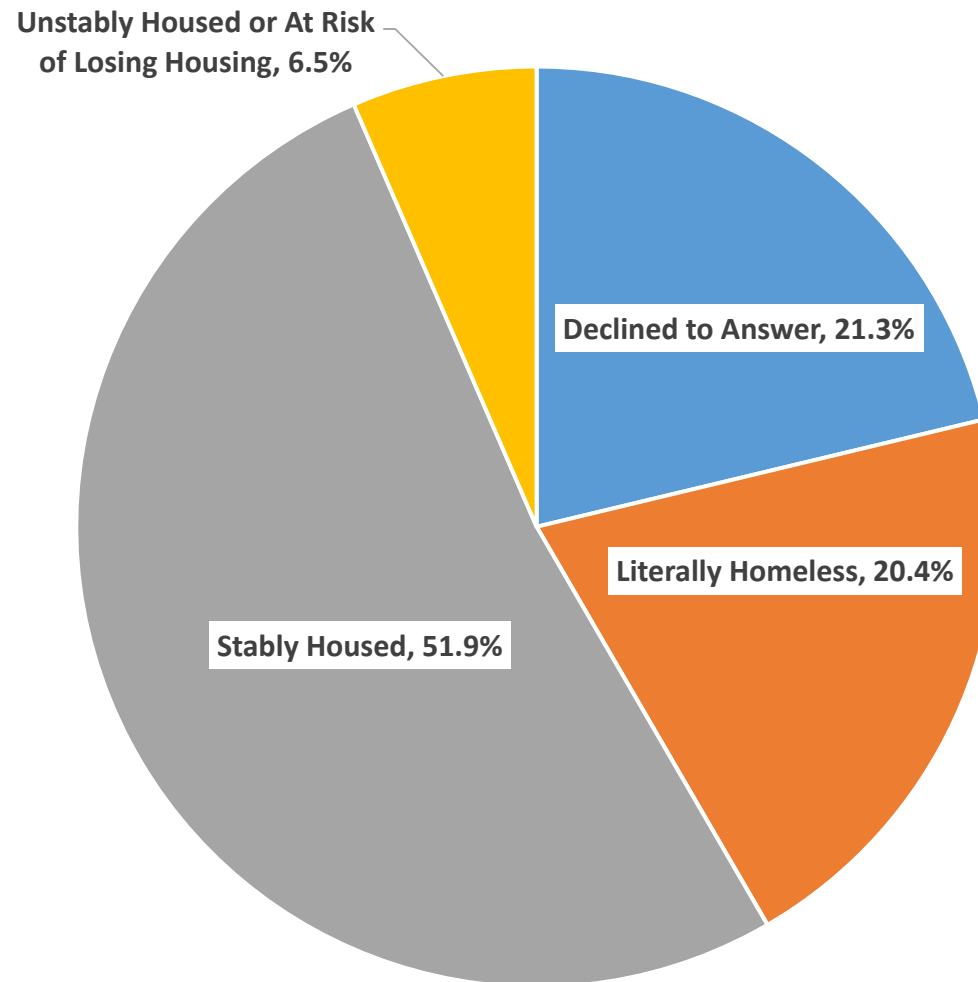
**Figure 6. Self-reported 'Most Often' Injection Location by SSP Clients, January-June, 2018  
(N = 1,615)**



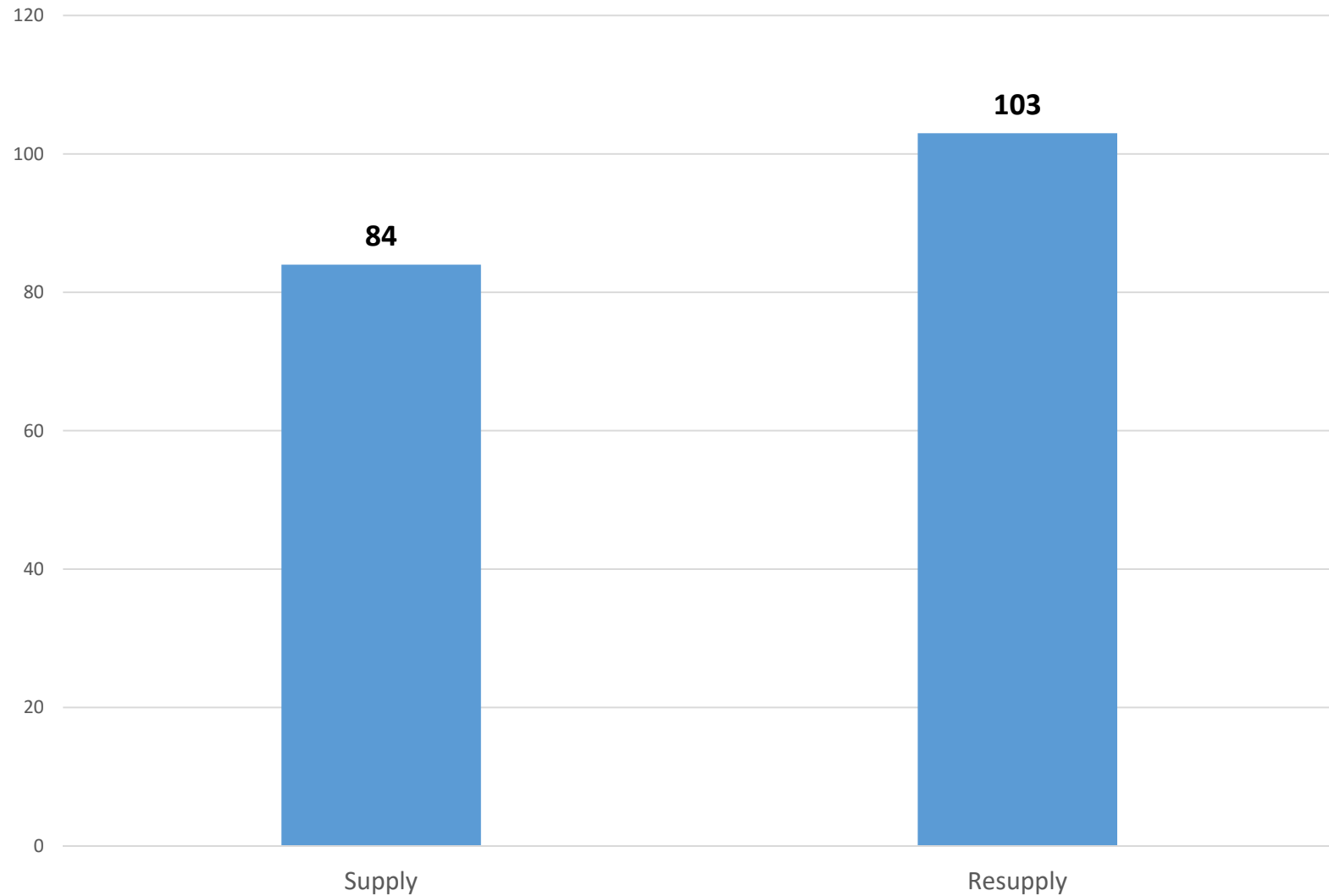
**Figure 7. Self-reported Hep A, Hep B, Hep C and HIV Status, January to June, 2018

(N=1,615)**

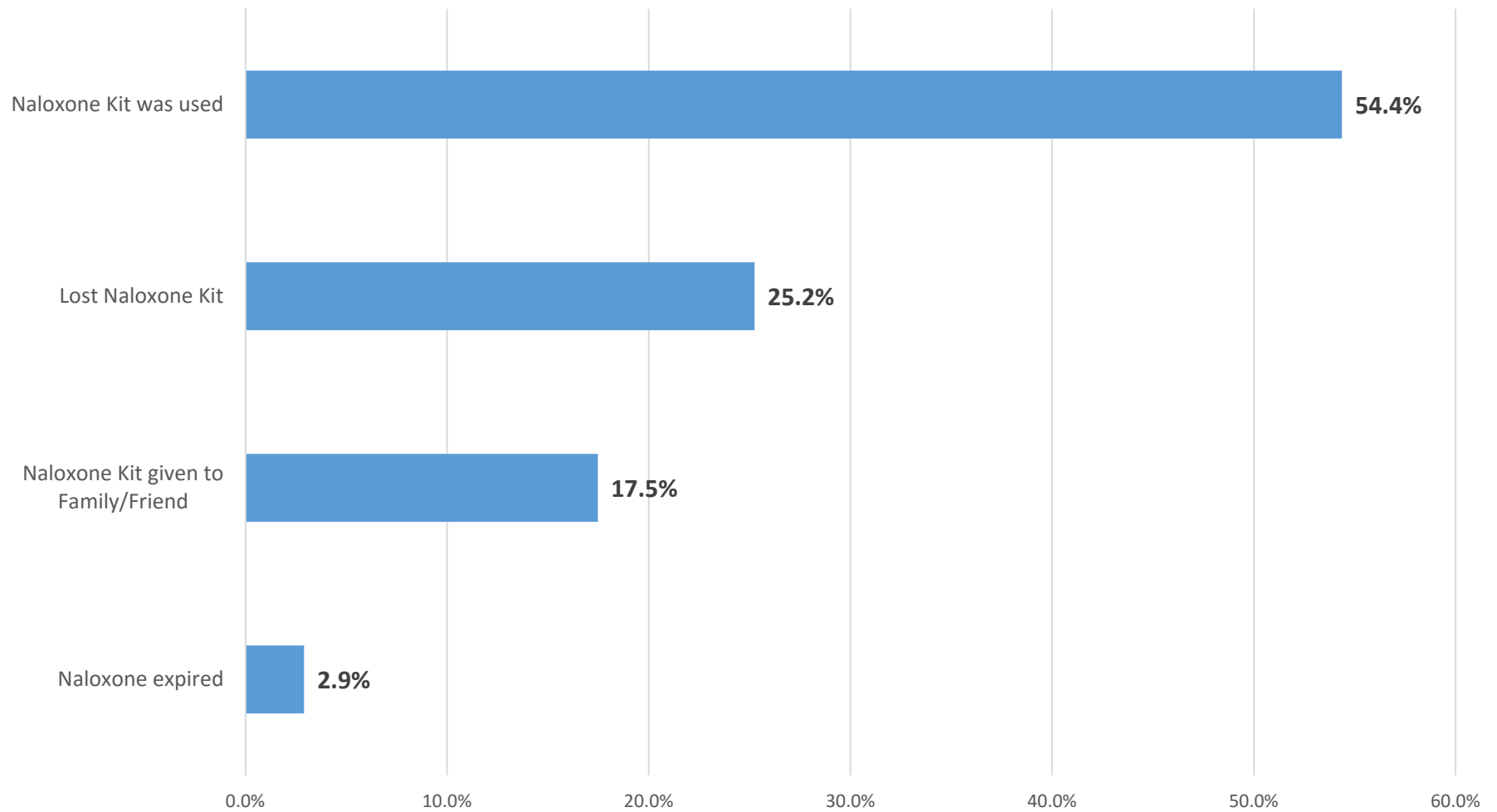


**Figure 9a. OD Kit (naloxone) Supply\*/Resupply to SSP Clients, January to June, 2018
