TIP: Incident Location type is now from the ICD-10-CM code list, dropdown lists for incident city and state. Use VALID 5 digit zip codes.

Usage: Indication of when the data element is expected to be collected.

Mandatory = Must be completed; does not allow for NOT values

Required = Must be completed and allows NOT values

Recommended = Does not need to be completed; allows NOT values

Optional = Does not need to be completed; does not allow for NOT values

Geographic coding, please consult your software vendor for drop down lists they can create for ePCRs (state and city codes and valid town zip codes)
