Congenital syphilis can result in miscarriage, newborn death, and severe lifelong physical andneurological problems

CASES IN MEN WHO HAVE SEX WITH MEN (MSM)

20% Co-infected with HIV





Protection from HIV = PrEP (Pre-exposure Prophylaxis)

PrEP only protects against HIV, condoms are important for the protection against other STDs
