The contract between New Opportunities, Inc. (the Contractor) and the Department of Social Services (the Department), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Commissioner at the Department of Social Services on 9/30/2015, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$31,439.00 from \$97,320.00 to \$128,759.00. The additional funds are to allow the Contractor to continue services for an additional 9 months.
2. The budget on page 3 of Amendment 1 shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the budget of page 2 of this amendment.
3. The term of this contract shall be extended by 9 months and the end date of the contract is changed from 9/30/16 to 6/30/17.
4. DSS contact/contract person on page 1 of the original contract shall be deleted and replaced as follows: Donna LoCurto at (860) 424-5323.
5. Item number 4 of Amendment 1 shall be revised as follows:
During the contract period ending 6/30/2017, Part I, Section A.1 Description of Services of the original contract shall include at least an additional 20 clients (individuals and/or families) receiving services for a total of 130 (for 10/1/14 – 6/30/17).
6. Part I, Section B, in the original contract, – Program Administration shall reflect revised staffing and percent of salary funded under this contract to include the following: Family Development Specialist (1) part-time @ 10 hours per week (100%)

All terms and conditions of the original Contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.






