Concerning
Issuance of Benefits in the State Supplement Program**

Section 1. Sections 6505 and 6505.05.A of the Department of Social Services' Uniform Policy Manual are amended as indicated in the attached document titled "Uniform Policy Manual Amendment."

Statement of Purpose

To require recipients of state supplementation to the Supplemental Security Income Program who do not reside in rated facilities to receive such benefits by direct deposit into a personal account at a financial institution or an electronic benefit transfer account, with certain limited exceptions for recipients who were born before May 1, 1921, suffer from a mental impairment or live in a disaster area.
