To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that effective Friday, July 1, 2016, private investigator registrations will no longer be issued until the Connecticut State Police Special Licensing and Firearms Unit (SLFU) has received the results of the fingerprint-supported national background check. The time that it takes to receive these results varies, but the current anticipated processing time for the fingerprints and associated background checks is estimated to be between 8-10 weeks.

Once the results of the background check are received from the FBI, the employer will be advised by mail whether the registration has been granted or denied.
