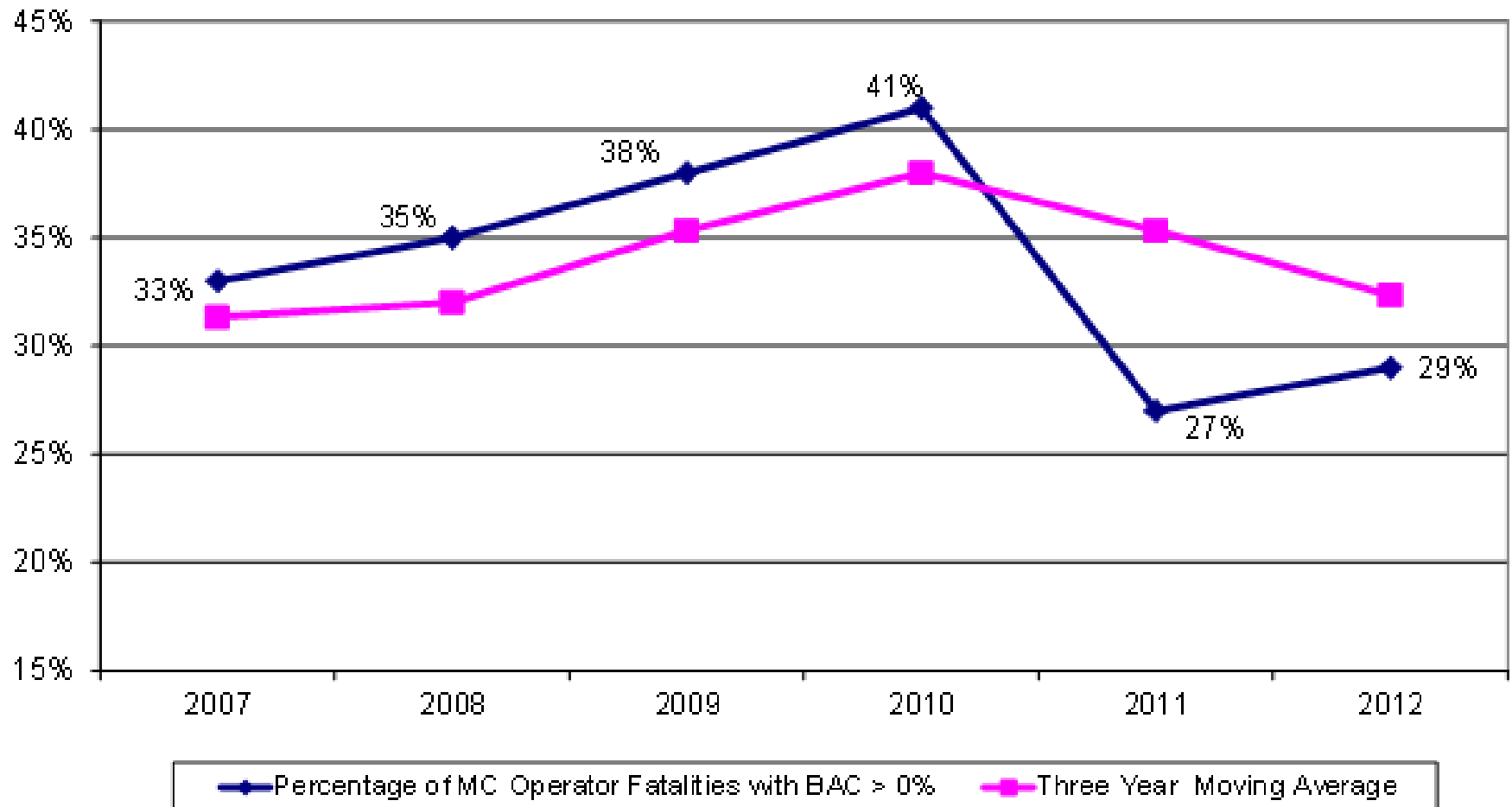

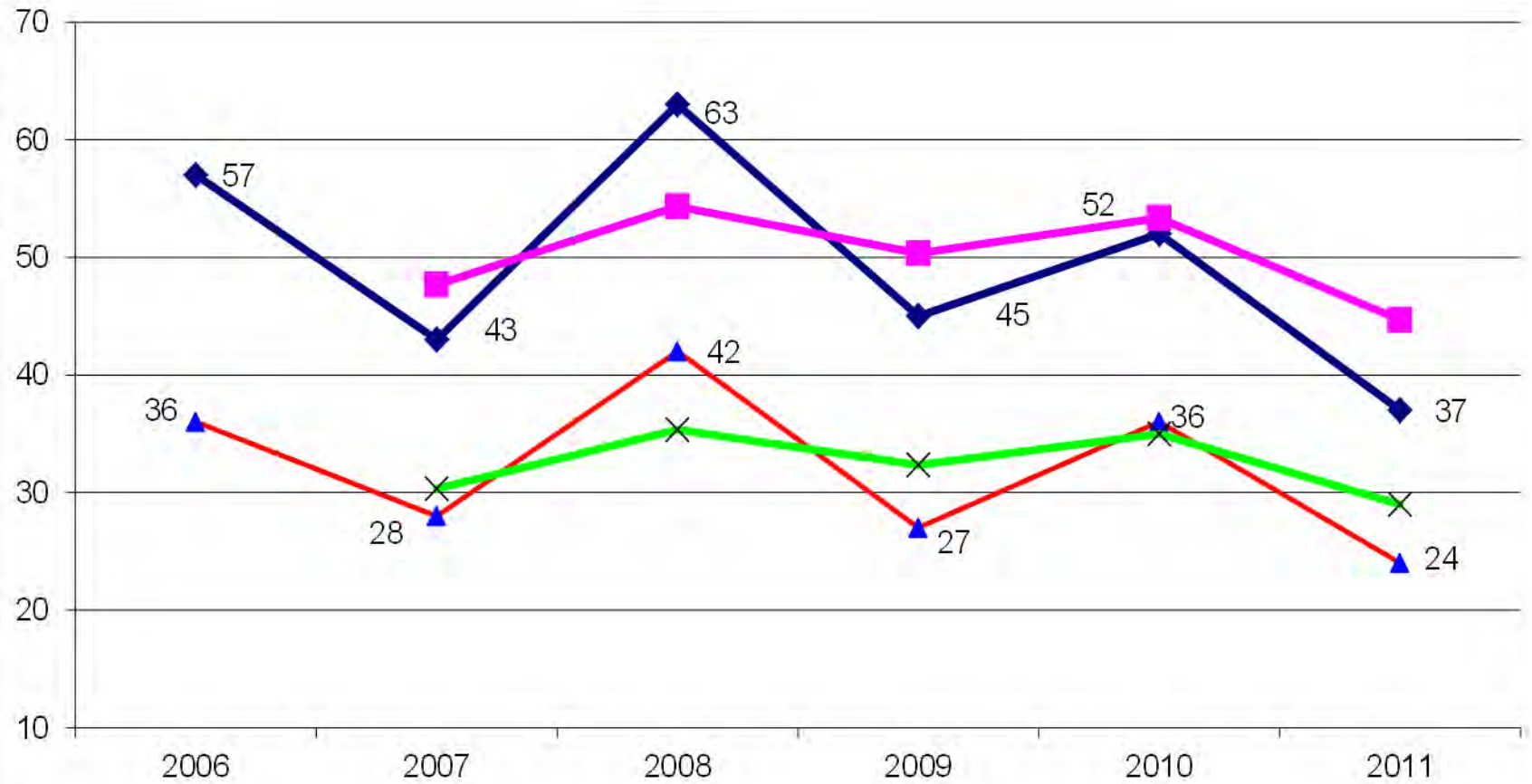

Instructors are responsible for conducting all Connecticut Rider Education Program courses including classroom sessions, demonstrating and conducting range exercises, and evaluating rider performance. Only instructors approved by the Department of Transportation may participate in the program. In order to remain approved for participation in the program instructors must:

Teach (PI or AI) a minimum of two CONREP courses per year or satisfy a combination of experience, training and testing requirements sufficient to establish proficiency to the satisfaction of CONREP officials

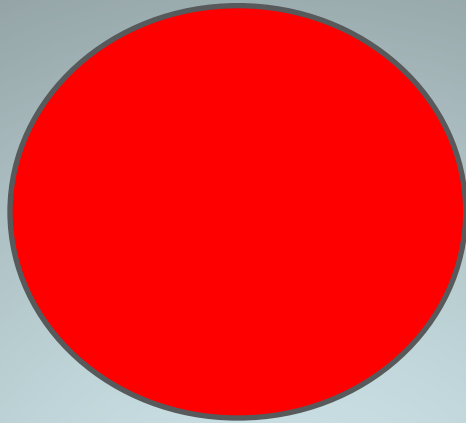

 - successfully complete CONREP update and informational seminars as required;
 - pass any on-site evaluations conducted by CONREP officials or their representative(s);
 - maintain a current, valid motor vehicle operator's license endorsed for motorcycle operation;
 - maintain MSF instructor certification and
 - maintain a good riding and driving record;
 - pass any motorcycle riding skills test and/or any knowledge test required by CONREP officials.

The Department of Transportation may suspend or revoke the approval to participate in the program for any instructor not meeting these requirements.
