The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on April 27, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondent appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

1. The respondent is a public agency.
2. On March 30, 1976, the complainant requested a copy of the most recent report of the traffic signs, signals, devices and markings required by § 14-314a, gen. stats. in the possession of the respondent.
3. By letter dated March 31, 1976, the above request was denied.
4. By letter of complaint filed with this Commission on April 6, 1976, the complainant alleged that this denial was in violation of P.A. 75-342.
5. The report is a public record and is not exempt from disclosure pursuant to §§ 2(b)(2) and (3) of P.A. 75-342.
6. The respondent represented at the hearing on this complaint that it has no objection to providing the complainant with access to the report in question.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

1. The respondent shall forthwith provide the complainant with a copy of the requested report described in paragraph 2, above.
2. Compliance with this order shall be in accordance with § 5 of P.A. 75-342.
