The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on May 19, 1976 and June 7, 1976 at which times the complainant and the respondents appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

- The respondents are public agencies.
- 2. On October 9, 1975 complainant requested access to the case file of the respondent commission. The file is designated as FEP-S180-1.
- 3. During the course of the hearing, the Commission ruled on an analogous case entitled <u>Berman</u> vs. the State of Connecticut docket #FIC 76-74 which was based upon Conn. Gen. Stat. 31-127 and P.A. 75-342 §2(a).
- 4. Respondent has voluntarily agreed to supply material in file FEP-S180-1 as required by Berman; Exhibit 4 has been so marked.
- 5. The personnel file of Mr. Barone (the subject of the respondent commission's investigation) does not exist in the respondent's file at the present time.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

- 1. The respondent commission shall forthwith provide the complainant with access to inspect or copy documents tendered at the hearing of June 7, 1976.
- 2. The Commission cautions that the files of respondent must be preserved in adequate condition so that the public may have appropriate access as provided by P.A. 75-342.
