

7. The complainant was on notice and did attend the meeting of the respondent board held on January 17, 1977.

8. The complainant did not request that the respondent board hold the aforesaid discussion at an open meeting pursuant to §1-18a(e)(1), G.S.

9. One of the individuals who was in attendance at the aforesaid executive session beyond the period necessary, as referred to in paragraph 4 of these findings, accompanied the complainant at the complaint's own behest during the period in which the complainant testified to the respondent board at its executive session.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:


1. Henceforth, the respondent board shall strictly limit attendance in executive session as required by §1-21g, G.S.
