The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on May 5, 1983 at which time the respondent board appeared and stipulated as follows:

- a. The Fire Commission will adhere to its obligations under §1-21, G.S. regarding the notice of all meetings.
- b. The Fire Commission will adhere to its obligation under §§1-21, 1-18 and 1-15, G.S. to make minutes of its meetings available to the public at the Chiefs office within seven days.
- c. The Fire Commission will strictly adhere to its obligation under §§1-21g, and 1-18a(e), G.S. in conducting executive sessions.
- d. The Fire Commission will adhere to the definition of meetings as contained in §1-18a(b), G.S.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint.

1. Henceforth the respondent board of Fire Commissioners shall act in strict compliance with the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act, as enumerated above.
