The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on May 9, 1983 at which time the complainant and the respondent appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record the following facts are found:

1. The respondent is a public agency within the meaning of §1-18a(a), G.S.

2. By letter of complaint filed with the commission on January 26, 1983, the complainant alleged that on September 7, 1982, the respondent met illegally in executive session.


3. §1-21i(b), G.S. sets forth a jurisdictional requirement that appeals to this Commission be filed within 30 days of the alleged denial of any right conferred by the Freedom of Information Act.

4. At hearing, the respondent moved to dismiss the complaint for lack of jurisdiction, which motion was granted.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
