The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on December 6, 1984 at which time the complainant and the respondent appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.


After consideration of the entire matter the following facts are found:

1. The respondent is a public agency within the meaning of §1-18a(a), G.S.
2. In response to the respondent's comments that he "kept a book or file" on the complainant, the complainant, by letter dated August 2, 1984, made a request of the respondent for all such information.
3. The complainant received no response to his August 2, 1984 letter.
4. By letter filed with the Commission on August 24, 1984 the complainant appealed the denial of his request for records.
5. It is found that the respondent maintains no "book or file" containing information regarding the complainant.
6. It is concluded that the complainant was not denied access to any public record within the meaning of §1-18a(d), G.S.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint.

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
