Dear Dr. Ehrlich:

On September 1, 2009, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your request seeking a waiver from Certificate of Need ("CON") requirements to replace equipment pursuant to Public Act 09-232. Please be advised that Public Act 09-232 provides that an applicant must have previously obtained a Certificate of Need or a Certificate of Need Determination with respect to the piece of equipment to be replaced before seeking a waiver from this office. Accordingly, OHCA is processing this request as a CON Determination pursuant to § 19a-639a (c) with respect to the acquisition of the mobile-based Siemens Impact, 1.0 tesla-strength MRI scanner by Housatonic Valley Radiological Associates in 2001. OHCA has reviewed this matter and makes the following findings:

- 1. Housatonic Valley Radiological Associates, P.C., ("Applicant") is a for-profit corporation, providing, in part, magnetic resonance imaging ("MRI") services at its office located at 800 Main Street in Southbury, Connecticut.
- 2. The Applicant currently owns and operates a mobile-based Siemens Impact, 1.0 tesla-strength MRI scanner at its Southbury office.
- 3. On May 4, 2001, the Applicant entered into an agreement with MRI/AMI Imaging Partners, LLC for the purchase of the mobile-based Siemens Impact, 1.0 tesla-strength MRI scanner at a total equipment expenditure of \$343,000.
- 4. The Applicant provided evidence demonstrating that it operated the mobile-based Siemens Impact, 1.0 tesla-strength MRI scanner prior to July 1 2005.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Housatonic Valley Radiological Associates, P.C., is not required to file a Certificate of Need request for the purchase of its existing mobile-based Siemens Impact, 1.0 tesla-strength MRI scanner, because the Applicant purchased this equipment prior to the implementation of Public Act 05-93 and the equipment was in operation prior to July 1, 2006.
