Relocation of an Outpatient Mammography Center in Mansfield

Dear Ms. Trantalis:

On September 25, 2009, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request on behalf of Windham Community Memorial Hospital ("WCMH") for the relocation of an Outpatient Mammography Center in Mansfield, Connecticut. OHCA has reviewed your request and makes the following findings:

- 1. WCMH is an acute care hospital located at 112 Mansfield Avenue in Willimantic, Connecticut.
- 2. WCMH currently provides outpatient mammography services under the Hospital's license at 155 Storrs Road in Mansfield.
- 3. WCMH is proposing to relocate its existing outpatient mammography center from 155 Storrs Road, Mansfield, to 7 Ledgebrook Drive, Mansfield.
- 4. The current and the target population for outpatient mammography services will not change as a result of the relocation.
- 5. No additional programs are proposed and no services will be terminated.
- 6. The WCMH contends that the total capital expenditure associated with the proposal is \$302,475.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for Windham Community Memorial Hospital's proposal to proceed with the relocation of the Hospital's Outpatient Mammography Center from 155 Storrs Road in Mansfield to 7 Ledgebrook Drive in Mansfield. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
