CON Determination Request; Report Number: 10-31620-DTR Saint Mary's Hospital & VITAS d/b/a VITAS Hospice Services, LLC Proposal to Establish Twelve Bed Inpatient Hospice Unit at Saint Mary's Hospital

Dear Mr. Connolly and Ms. Bachhuber:

On May 18, 2010, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request on behalf of Saint Mary's Hospital ("SMH") and VITAS d/b/a VITAS Hospice Services, LLC ("VITAS") with respect to the proposal to establish a twelve bed inpatient hospice unit at SMH. OHCA has reviewed your request and makes the following findings:

- 1. SMH is a short term acute care general hospital located at 56 Franklin Street, Waterbury, Connecticut.
- 2. VITAS is a national hospice company that provides inpatient and outpatient hospice and is Medicare certified.
- 3. VITAS is licensed to provide hospice services by the Department of Public Health ("DPH").
- 4. SMH currently provides end-of-life care for its hospital patients pursuant to written inpatient agreements with various hospice providers, including VITAS.
- 5. Pursuant to the above-referenced agreements, the hospice patient is placed in an available hospital bed and receives inpatient services provided by the hospital and professionally managed by the hospice.

- 6. SMH seeks to enhance these services by jointly establishing a dedicated hospice unit operated by VITAS.
- 7. The proposed unit is authorized under Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospice, 42 C.F.R. § 418 et.seq. ("CoPs").
- 8. Under the CoPs, hospices may provide inpatient hospice care directly, as well as under arrangements with a Medicare certified hospital or skilled nursing facility.
- 9. VITAS will lease the space from SMH for provision of drect hospice services to residents of greater Waterbury as authorized under 42 C.F.R. § 418.100.
- 10. The twelve beds are within SMH's licensed bed capacity.
- 11. VITAS will institute policies and procedures governing the hospice unit and provide training on hospice care and end-of-life issues for VITAS staff and any SMH staff working in the unit.
- 12. VITAS will also maintain ultimate responsibility for the hospice plan of care as required by the CoPs.
- 13. VITAS will be responsible for all billing related to services provided.
- 14. The estimated total project cost is \$1,037,618.

Based upon the above findings, OHCA has determined that the proposal does not require Certificate of Need approval as it does not involve a transfer of ownership, an additional function or service or a termination of service under §19a-638. Additionally, CON approval is not required pursuant to § 19a-639, as the estimated total project cost of \$1,037,618 is below the \$3 million threshold.
