Dear Mr. Hartley:

On May 11, 2011, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") determination request on behalf of Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center with respect to whether a CON is required for the establishment of a temporary satellite urgent care clinic to serve the Travelers Championship Golf Tournament in Cromwell for the time period June 18, 2011 to June 26, 2011. The Hospital has a contract with Travelers Championship to assure a minimum of one to two board certified and/or eligible physicians, and/or physician assistants, APRNS, four registered nurses and no less than ten certified emergency technicians and/or licensed paramedics. Emergency Services are provided by Hunter's Ambulance, Rocky Hill Volunteer Ambulance, and Cromwell Fire Department by contract directly with Travelers. The Hospital will coordinate emergency services with these entities.

OHCA has determined that CON approval is not required for the proposal as a temporary satellite urgent care clinic is not a health care facilty as defined in General Statutes §19a-630.
