Dear Ms. Stromstad and Mr. Messina:

The Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") is in receipt of three Certificate of Need ("CON") applications for the transfer of ownership of Waterbury Imaging Center Limited Partnership, LLC, Imaging Partners, LLC, and Valley Imaging Partners, LLC, related to the proposed change of ownership of the Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN").

However, according to OHCA's records, CON approval related to the proposed change of ownership may also be required for: the Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Harold Leever Cancer Center, a 64-Slice Computed Tomography scanner owned and operated by The Waterbury Hospital and the off-site Waterbury Hospital Sleep Laboratory. OHCA requests that you file a CON Determination (available at www.ct.gov/ohca) for each of the above four items, so that OHCA can formally determine if a CON is required pursuant Connecticut General Statutes § 19a-638.

Please file the four CON Determination requests by January 31, 2014. If for any reason, you are unable to do so by that date, you must file a written explanation detailing the need for the time extension prior to January 31, 2014.



PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION:

No licensed services are provided by the entity known as "The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. No service changes are requested. The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. serves residents of the following towns: Beacon Falls, Bethlehem, Cheshire, Middlebury, Morris, Naugatuck, Oakville, Oxford, Plantsville, Plymouth, Prospect, Seymour, Southbury, Southington, Terryville, Thomaston, Torrington, Waterbury, Watertown, Wolcott and Woodbury.

As detailed in Docket No. 08-31302-CON, in order to develop the open heart program at Saint Mary's Hospital ("Saint Mary's") and The Waterbury Hospital, the two hospitals formed a corporation for the limited purpose of preparing and submitting an Application for a Certificate of Need and related administrative functions. This corporation is "The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc." ("Historic Entity").

The Certificate of Need for the Waterbury open heart program provides that the approved services are to be rendered by St. Mary's or WH. The Historic Entity does not and has never provided any health care services. Currently, it has one employee who provides heart care education in the community; it also coordinates the reporting required under the Agreed Settlement. Both of these functions would be performed by either hospital in the future.

Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN"), on behalf of its affiliates and subsidiaries, GWHN signed a Letter of Intent to form a joint venture with a subsidiary of Vanguard Health Systems, Inc. ("Vanguard", collectively the "JV"). GWHN and Vanguard submitted to the Attorney General and the Commissioner of the Department of Public Health an application for approval of the JV under Conn. Gen. Stat. § 19a-486 et seq. on May 3, 2013 (as supplemented by responses to completeness questions, Docket Number; 13-31838-CON, the "Application"). Vanguard is now a wholly owned subsidiary of Tenet Health Care, Inc.

The terms of the JV contemplate GWHN's contribution of substantially all of its assets to the JV in exchange for a 20% ownership interest in the JV. At Bates Number 00015 of the Application, Applicants list GWHN Contributed Assets which includes the interests held by Waterbury Hospital in various affiliates, including the Heart Center. While not yet formally submitted, GWHN and Vanguard have agreed that Waterbury Hospital's interest in the Heart Center will not be among the Contributed Assets and the first amendment to the JV Application, when filed, will so reflect that agreement. This interest will continue to be held in the entity now called "The Waterbury Hospital". The Waterbury Hospital entity will serve as the post conversion foundation; after the conversion, the Hospital will be renamed to reflect its new role. There is no anticipated transfer of the Waterbury Hospital's interest in the Heart Center to the JV or any other party.

Dear Ms. Stromstad:

On February 7, 2014, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination Form on behalf of The Waterbury Hospital d/b/a The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. ("Petitioner") with respect to The Waterbury Hospital's interest in the Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. following the joint venture between Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN") and Vanguard Health Systems, Inc. ("Vanguard").

In order to develop an open heart program at Saint Mary's Hospital and The Waterbury Hospital, the two entities formed The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. for the limited purpose of preparing and submitting a CON application. The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. does not and has never provided any health care services. It currently has one employee who provides heart care education in the community. GWHN is the parent corporation of the Petitioner. GWHN and Vanguard are seeking to complete a joint venture which will include the contribution of substantially all of GWHN's assets to the joint venture in exchange for a 20% ownership interest in the joint venture. The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. will not be included in those assets. Instead, it will remain an entity held by The Waterbury Hospital. There will be no impact or change in the governance or control of The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. The CON application filed under Docket Number 13-31838-CON will be amended to reflect this understanding.

Connecticut General Statutes § 19a-638(a)(2) requires CON authorization for the "transfer of ownership of a health care facility". Connecticut General Statutes § 19a-630(14) defines a "transfer of ownership" as "a transfer that impacts or changes the governance or controlling body of a health care facility or institution..."Based upon the Petitioner's representation that The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc. will be excluded from the joint venture and that there will be no impact or change in the governance or control of The Heart Center of Greater Waterbury, Inc., OHCA concludes that a CON *is not required* for the Petitioner's proposal.
