- a. Proposal/Project Title: Transfer of Greater Waterbury Management Resources, Inc.'s Ownership Interest in Valley Imaging Partners, LLC to a subsidiary of Prospect Medical Holdings, Inc. as part of Proposed Asset Purchase by Prospect Medical Holdings, Inc. under OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486.

## PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN") and Prospect Medical Holdings, Inc., ("Prospect") (collectively, the "Applicants") submitted to the Attorney General and the Commissioner of the Department of Public Health an application for approval of a proposed asset purchase of GWHN by Prospect under OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486. That proposed transaction involves the acquisition of substantially all of the assets of GWHN by one or more subsidiaries of Prospect. Among these assets is a limited liability company interest in Valley Imaging Partners, LLC ("Valley Imaging"), which interest is owned by Greater Waterbury Management Resources, Inc. ("GWMRI"), a wholly owned subsidiary of GWHN. The transaction is further described in the draft Asset Purchase Agreement set forth in OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486.

Valley Imaging is currently owned by GWMRI and a private physician practice; GWHN holds an indirect 49% ownership interest in Valley Imaging through its wholly owned subsidiary, GWMRI, and the private physician practice owns 51%. Valley Imaging provides outpatient advanced imaging services. It maintains an office at 800 Main Street South in Southbury and owns and operates an MRI at 799 New Haven Road in Naugatuck. Valley Imaging is not a health care facility and is therefore not licensed.

Valley Imaging serve patients in towns including, but not limited to, Beacon Falls, Bethlehem, Cheshire, Middlebury, Morris, Naugatuck, Oakville, Oxford, Plantsville, Plymouth, Prospect, Seymour, Southbury, Southington, Terryville, Thomaston, Torrington, Waterbury, Watertown, Wolcott, and Woodbury.

Under the proposed asset purchase under review in OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486, GWHN will cause GWMRI to transfer its interest in Valley Imaging to a subsidiary of Prospect. The transfer of this interest in Valley Imaging to Prospect is an integral component of the proposed acquisition; and is therefore already subject to CON review by OHCA. The proposed transaction does not affect the ownership of the MRI. The MRI scanner will remain the sole property of the Valley Imaging and no other person, physician or provider will acquire any interest. Exclusive ownership of Valley Imaging assets will remain with Valley Imaging and will not change after GWHN causes the sale of GWMRI's interest to PMH or its subsidiary.

As described in the transaction under review in OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486, no changes in services are being proposed. After the acquisition, Valley Imaging will continue to serve the residents of the same service area from the same location.

Based on the foregoing, GWHN and Prospect respectfully request a determination that the transfer of the GWMRI's interest in Valley Imaging to a subsidiary of Prospect as contemplated in the proposed asset purchase under review in OHCA Docket Number 15-32017-486 does not require separate CON approval pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. Sec. 19a-638 because Valley Imaging will retain sole ownership of and continue to operate the MRI scanner subsequent to the sale of GWMRI's interest to PMH or its subsidiary.

Dear Ms. Stromstad and Mr. Spees:

On April 5, 2016, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request on behalf of Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN") and Prospect Medical Holdings, Inc. ("PMH") with respect to the transfer of ownership of Greater Waterbury Management Resources, Inc.'s ("GWMR") ownership interest in Valley Imaging Partners, LLC ("VIP").

VIP is an imaging center currently owned by GWMR and a private physician practice. GWHN holds a 49% ownership interest in VIP through its wholly owned subsidiary, GWMR, and the private physician practice owns 51%. VIP owns and operates one MRI scanner under existing Certificate of Need authorizations.

Currently, there is a pending certificate of need application (Docket Number 15-32017-486) under review by OHCA and the Office of the Attorney General for a proposed asset purchase of GWHN by PMH. That proposal involves GWMR transferring its interest in VIP to a subsidiary of PMH. The proposed transaction does not affect the ownership of the MRI. The MRI will remain the sole property of VIP and no other person, physician or provider will acquire any interest. Exclusive ownership of VIP assets will remain with VIP and will not change after GWHN sells its interest to PMH or its subsidiary.

VIP currently owns the MRI Scanner. Subsequent to the proposed asset purchase by PMH, VIP will continue to own the MRI Scanner. Consequently, no other person, physician or provider will acquire any interest in the MRI Scanner. Therefore, a *CON is not required* for the proposal.
