FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT COMPANY REGISTRATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN
THE SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

This release serves as notification concerning the mandatory registration requirement of food service management companies that must be met in order to participate in the 2009 Summer Food Service Program in Connecticut. Sponsors of the Summer Food Service Program may contract only with food service management companies that have registered with the Connecticut State Department of Education.

On or before March 28, 2009, each food service management company that desires to participate in the program within the State of Connecticut must submit an application or renewal for registration to the Connecticut State Department of Education. The application form for registration can be obtained by writing the Connecticut State Department of Education, Bureau of Health/Nutrition, Family Services and Adult Education, 25 Industrial Park Road, Middletown, Connecticut 06457-1543 or calling Robert Zwack at 860-807-2081.
