FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

A special education hearing in the above-captioned matter was requested by Student via letter dated January 14, 2010. The request for due process hearing was received by the Due Process Unit on January 19, 2010. It is assumed that it was received by the Board of Education on the same date. Therefore, the 30-day resolution period runs through February 18, 2010 and the deadline for mailing the final decision and order is April 4, 2010.

The case was scheduled for a pre-hearing conference on February 5, 2010. Via letter dated February 1, 2010, Student withdrew the matter with prejudice because the parties reached a settlement at the resolution session. Based on Student's withdrawal, the Hearing Officer cancelled the scheduled pre-hearing conference.

The issues in this case were whether the Board of Education should reimburse Student for an out-of-district placement for the 2009-10 school year and whether the Board of Education denied Student a free appropriate public education.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

In light of the above facts, the above-captioned case is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
