**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board failed to offer FAPE for the 2010-2011 school year, including extended year services;
2. Whether the Student requires a private day therapeutic educational placement;
3. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Ben Bronz Academy;
4. Whether the Student should receive compensatory services.

**SUMMARY:**

On June 1, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. A Prehearing Conference was held on June 14, 2010 and hearing dates were scheduled. On June 29, 2010, Counsel for the Parent notified the Hearing Officer that the matter had been settled, withdrew the Request for Due Process, and requested that the matter be dismissed with prejudice.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
