FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2009-10 school year was appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Student shall be provided compensatory education in the form of appropriate instruction through a certified math teacher.

The Board received this request for hearing on June 28, 2010, and a prehearing conference convened on July 8, 2010. The hearing convened on August 8. On August 17, 2010, prior to the second hearing date, the Parent submitted notification that the matter had settled. This matter is dismissed, with prejudice.
